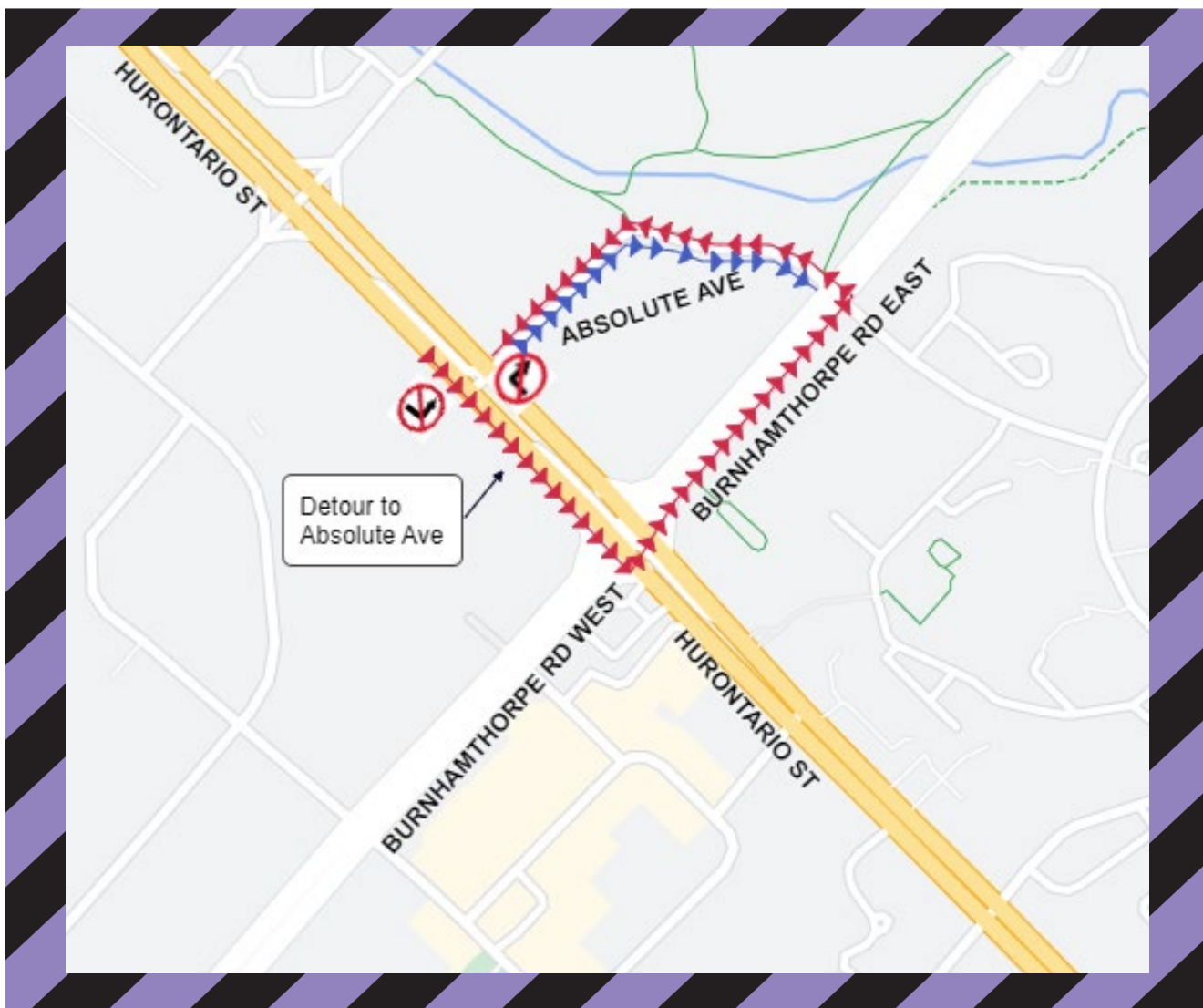


# Partial Road Closure of Absolute Avenue at Hurontario Street

Tuesday August 1 to Saturday August 5, 2023

Works are scheduled to take place from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily.



## What work is taking place?

Crews will be installing Alectra duct banks at Hurontario Street near Absolute Avenue from Tuesday August 1 to Saturday August 5, 2023. This work requires the partial closure of Absolute Avenue at Hurontario Street. Vehicles will be restricted from turning left and right from Hurontario Street to Absolute Avenue. Construction works are scheduled 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily. Access for Emergency Service Vehicles will be maintained.

Please follow posted detour signs while navigating around the road closure. Detours routes include Hurontario Street, Burnhamthorpe Road and Absolute Avenue.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axes, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

## TIMING

- Access from Hurontario Street to Absolute Avenue will be restricted from August 1 to August 5, 2023.
- Works are scheduled to take place from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

## TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Please follow signs for detour routes which are also shown on the map.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

## WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks,

excavators, loaders, tri-axes, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.
