
# Street Light Pole Removal and Installation at the southwest corner of Eglinton Avenue West and Duplex Avenue

# What Work is Taking Place?

As early as Monday, July 24, 2023, crews will begin removing the old street light pole and installing a new one on the southwest corner of Eglinton Avenue West and Duplex Avenue. To facilitate this work safely, a work zone will be in place in the south lane on Eglinton Avenue West, west of Duplex Avenue. Eastbound through, right, and left turning traffic on Eglinton Avenue West will be maintained at Duplex Avenue. Pedestrians will be rerouted safely around the work zone. All other traffic staging will remain in place. This work is expected to take place on Monday to Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. for approximately three (3) days. Upon completion of this work, short term lane reductions may be required to facilitate special activities. For more information, please review the complete notice or visit www.thecrosstown.ca

# What to Expect

Traffic barrels and fencing will be in place to delineate pedestrians from the work zones and traffic. Temporary pedestrian rerouting will be implemented. Noise from construction activity including concrete breaking and truck staging can be expected. Periodic use of a hydro-vacuum truck will be required to facilitate certain works. Expect delays while travelling through the intersection.

# **HOURS OF WORK**

- As early as Monday, July 24, 2023, for approximately three (3) days.
- Construction activities are expected to take place on Monday Friday between 7:00 a.m. 6:00 p.m.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- Work may be longer or shorter than expected.

### **TRAFFIC DETAILS**

- A work zone will be in place in the south lane on Eglinton Avenue West, west of Duplex Avenue.
- Eastbound through, right, and left turning traffic on Eglinton Avenue West will be maintained at Duplex Avenue.

### **PEDESTRIAN DETAILS**

• Pedestrians will be safely rerouted around the construction zone.
