We acknowledge that Metrolinx operates on territories and lands covered by many treaties that affirm and value the rights of Indigenous communities, Nations and Peoples.



WESTON ROAD TO BLACK CREEK DRIVE TRAFFIC CONFIGURATION





RAIL CORRIDOR STAGING - HAUL ROUTES

EMSF, TESTING & COMMISSIONING UPDATE

Ongoing through 2023

- Eglinton Crosstown LRVs are now being tested, as single and coupled vehicles, on the mainline between Mount Dennis Station and Caledonia Station
- Each train that will operate daily service on the line must go through rigorous testing to ensure safety and reliability
- Testing includes clearance tests, signal and wayside equipment testing, testing multiple vehicles, speed and brake tests
 to name a few







EMSF, TESTING & COMMISSIONING UPDATE

Ongoing through 2023

- Each of the 76 trains that will operate daily service between Mount Dennis and Kennedy must go through rigorous testing to ensure everything is working safely and reliably
