What work is taking place?

Construction crews will be installing Alectra duct bank crossings that will impact the eastbound ramp from Rathburn Road to Hurontario Street. This will involve nightly closures of the eastbound ramp from Rathburn Road to Hurontario Street, from Monday August 14, 2023, to Saturday 19, 2023, between the hours of 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. **Access for emergency vehicles will not be maintained during construction.**

A detour route to Hurontario Street from eastbound Rathburn Road will be available via Shipp Drive and Robert Speck Parkway. The ramp will be accessible to motorists during the day.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TIMING

- Work is scheduled to start from August 14, 2023, to August 19, 2023.
- This will include overnight work throughout the duration of this closure on a nightly basis between the hours of 7 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- The eastbound ramp from Rathburn Road to Hurontario Street will be closed nightly, reopening by 7 a.m. the following day.
- Please see the map for detours
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Access for emergency vehicles will not be maintained during construction.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

WHATTO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles and other construction equipment related to this work.
