
Sidewalk Deficiency Work at 1065 Eglinton Avenue West and 1071 Eglinton Avenue West

Monday, August 14, 2023



What Work is Taking Place?

As early as Monday, August 14, 2023, crews at Cedarvale Station will be performing sidewalk deficiency work at 1065 Eglinton Avenue West and 1071 Eglinton Avenue West. To facilitate this work safely, eastbound traffic on Eglinton Avenue West will be reduced to one lane between Strathearn Road and Flanders Road. Pedestrians will be safely rerouted around the work zone. Detours will be clearly marked with signage to direct pedestrians to the alternate routes. Affected

properties have been notified directly. This work is expected to take place between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. for approximately two (2) days. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times on Eglinton Avenue. Upon completion of this work, short term lane reductions may be required on Eglinton Avenue to facilitate special activities.

What to Expect

Noise and vibration from construction activity can be expected. Concrete barriers, fencing, and signage will be in place to delineate the work zones. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times on Eglinton Avenue East. Access to properties will be maintained at all times. Affected properties have been notified directly. Expect delays while traveling through the area.

HOURS OF WORK

- As early as Monday, August 14, 2023, for approximately two (2) days.
- Work is expected to take place on Monday to Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
- This work may be longer or shorter than expected.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Eastbound traffic on Eglinton Avenue West will be reduced to one lane between Strathearn Road and Flanders Road.
- One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Access to 1065 Eglinton Avenue West and 1071 Eglinton Avenue West will be restricted for the duration of work.
- Pedestrians will be safely rerouted around the work zone. Detours will be clearly marked with signage to direct pedestrians to the alternate routes.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- Access to TTC will be maintained at all times.
