

Notice of tree removal and protection at King St and Bathurst St

Expected start date: As early as August 10, 2023

Expected duration: Up to August 18th, 2023

Hours of work: Weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

What is happening?

- Six trees to be removed to provide space to build the new Ontario Line station at King and Bathurst. Four trees to be protected.
- There will be a tree nest inspection as early as August 10th to ensure all nests are found and safe prior to work beginning.
- Protected trees will be surrounded by barriers constructed of solid wood frames as per Toronto Standards.

What to expect

- There will be traffic control in place as well as temporary directional barriers and pedestrian control in place.
- Equipment such as a chainsaw, bucket truck and woodchipper equipment will be on site.
- Some noise is expected with this work while removals are underway.
- As always, please take care when travelling near work sites.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to unforeseen weather conditions.

About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
