


Figure 1: Map showing Eastern Avenue reduced to one lane in each direction.

WHAT WORK IS TAKING PLACE?

To safely facilitate the ongoing work on the Eastern Avenue Bridge, closures of the curb lanes on Eastern Avenue in both Eastbound and Westbound directions between Lewis Street and Dibble Street will be in effect starting mid-August / early September. Furthermore, please be advised that short-term and long-term lane closures along Eastern Avenue will be ongoing between now and approximately October 2025, to create a safe working zone for the crews and vehicle traffic.

THE SMARTTRACK EAST HARBOUR TRANSIT HUB

The new East Harbour Transit Hub will be located just east of the Don River and north of Lakeshore Boulevard East, in the Riverdale neighbourhood. This interchange station, on the Lakeshore East GO line, will provide seamless connectivity to more GO services, the future Ontario Line, and the TTC Broadview streetcar, in a corner of the city that is poised for growth. The East Harbour Transit Hub will also divert some of the commuter traffic away from Union Station and will be an alternate station for transferring between transit lines and services.

- Residents and businesses in the area should expect some noise, vibration, and dust.
- There will be no idling of non-essential equipment.
- Work area will be safely delineated.
