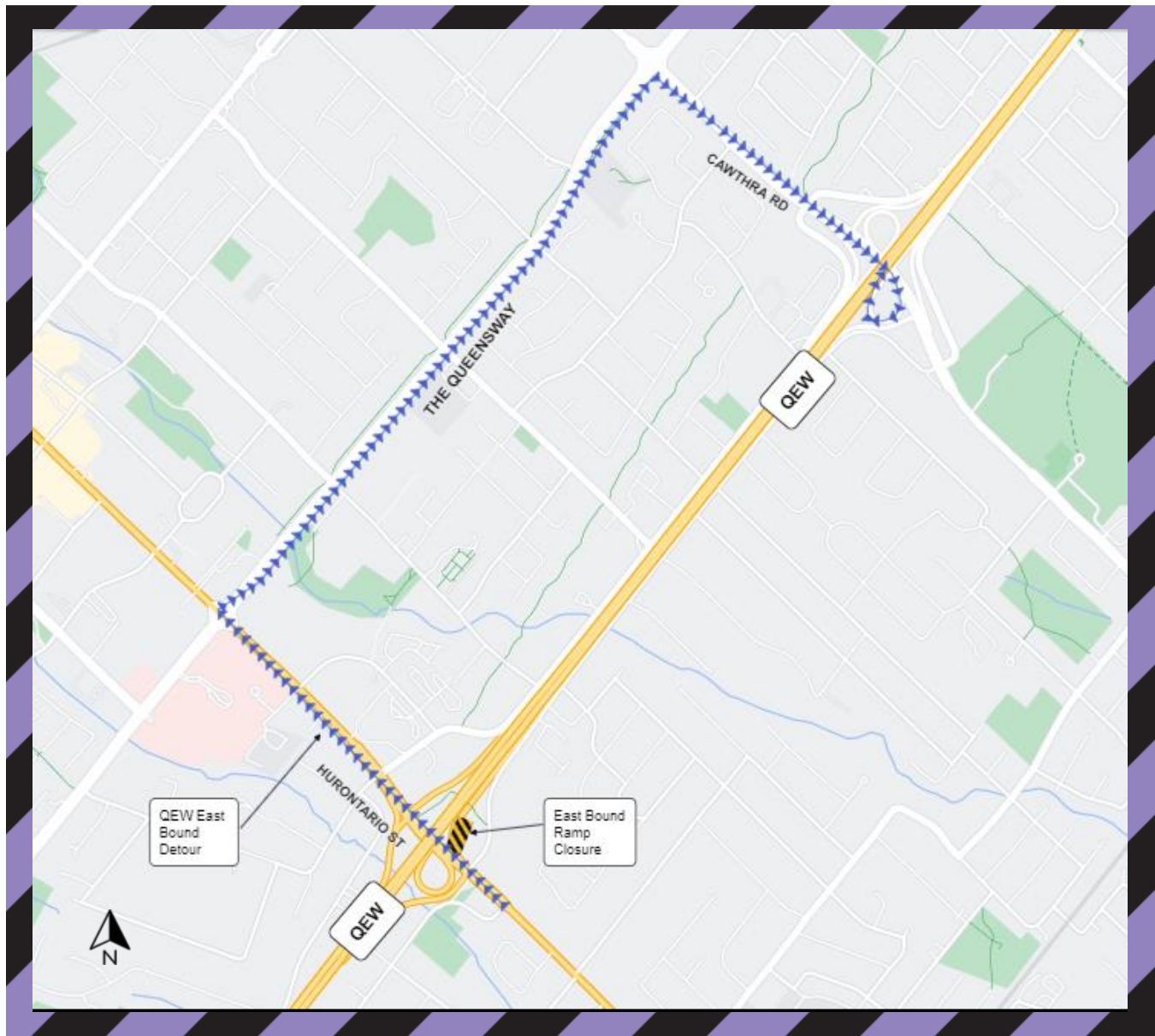


# Temporary QEW Eastbound On-Ramp Closure at Hurontario Street

Beginning Friday August 18, 2023 at 10 p.m. to Monday August 21, 2023 at 5 a.m.



## What work is taking place?

Starting **August 18, 2023, at 10 p.m.**, crews will work around the clock over the weekend to relocate the eastbound on-ramp at the QEW highway and Hurontario Street. This will make room for northbound traffic lanes on Hurontario Street to use the new underpass structure at the QEW that was built and pushed into place last fall. Once complete, there will be enough space for the construction of the LRT guideway along Hurontario Street that is expected to take place next year. This work will be continuous and is scheduled to be completed by **5 a.m. on August 21, 2023**, at which point the relocated eastbound on-ramp at the QEW and Hurontario Street will be reopened for motorists.

A detour route to access the eastbound QEW will be available via The Queensway East to Cawthra Road. The eastbound on-ramp at Hurontario Street will be temporarily inaccessible to all motorists, including emergency service vehicles, during the closure. All vehicles are encouraged to use the assigned detour route as depicted in the map above.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axes, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

### TIMING

- Work is scheduled to start on August 18, 2023, at 10 p.m. and will be completed by August 21, 2023, at 5 a.m.
- This will include continuous and overnight work, lasting the entire weekend.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

### TRAFFIC DETAILS

- The eastbound on-ramp to the QEW from Hurontario Street will be closed for the weekend.
- Please see the map for detours
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

### WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axes and other construction equipment related to this work.

### TRANSIT DETAILS

- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas will be relocated.

### PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Sidewalk access in the area could be affected.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

### PROPERTY DETAILS

- Please ensure any personal belongings, such as signs, benches and underground sprinklers on city owned land have been relocated prior to the beginning of construction.
- For details on your property boundaries, please refer to your land survey, or consult an Ontario Land Surveyor.
