Project Overview

As part of GO Expansion, Metrolinx has identified various infrastructure improvements like new tracks, train layovers, switches, bridge modifications and safer crossings to benefit rail service. GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What You Need to Know

Metrolinx will be working within the Kitchener Rail Corridor on the railtracks south of Woodbine Rack Track from August 25 to 27 starting at 10:00 p.m. Friday August 25 and running through until Sunday at 9:00 a.m. Metrolinx will remove a portion of the track (Turnout) and replace it with a new straight track panel. Large equipment is expected for the Turnout Removal such as excavators, boom trucks, and dump trucks. All efforts will be made to minimize community impacts.

- Work will being on Friday August 25 and conclude on Sunday August 27
- Work will be restricted to within the Kitchener Rail Corriror
- Large equipment will be in use to complete the work such as excavators, boom trucks, dump trucks, and more
- Businesses in the area may experiences elevated activity in the corridor area as well as elevated light, noise, and vibration
- All efforts will be made to minimize community impacts
