

# Updated - Access Road Construction at Pape Ave and Gerrard St E

As Early As August 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023

Monday to Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.



## What is happening?

- As early as Monday, August 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023, crews will begin building an access road into the railway corridor from the work zone shown on the map.
- To safely complete this work, the sidewalk at the north end of Pape Ave will be closed; **access to the pedestrian bridge and Gerrard Square will be maintained.**
- The sidewalk will reopen upon completion of the work.
- The work is expected to take approximately one (1) week to complete.
- This access road is required to facilitate upgrades to the rail corridor that are needed as part of the Ontario Line project.

# Traffic and Pedestrian Details

## Pedestrians:

- The sidewalk at the north end of Pape Ave will be closed; **access to the pedestrian bridge and Gerrard Square will be maintained.**

## What to Expect

- Clear signage will be posted to direct pedestrians and drivers.
- Traffic barrels, safety fencing and barricades will be in place to prevent drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians from entering work areas.
- Businesses and other organizations near the site can expect to hear noise from excavators and other machinery. Various mitigations will be in place to ensure that noise stays within acceptable levels and adheres to relevant bylaws and regulations.
- Construction equipment and materials will be properly secured within the work zones.
- When construction vehicles enter or exit the rail corridor, three traffic control personnel will be present at the access point to coordinate the safe movement of vehicles and ensure pedestrian safety.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

## About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer car trips each day.
