

# Demolition – 36 Overlea Blvd

Expected start date: August 30

Expected completion date: November 10

Hours of work: Weekdays from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.



## What is happening?

- The building at 36 Overlea Boulevard will be demolished in August as part of ongoing construction for the upcoming Ontario Line. The above image shows the demolition site.
- The building is now vacant, and the property has been secured with temporary safety fencing.
- Construction crews will be onsite through to November to conduct the demolition.

## What to expect

- Residents and businesses in the area can expect to hear typical construction noise and vibration.
- The building will be torn down, beginning with the interior.
- The building will be deconstructed piece by piece in the reverse order from how it was constructed.
- There will be no impacts to sidewalks, roads, or driveways for this work.
- Waste bins will be at the site and removed/replaced as required.
- Any equipment left on site will be secured within the temporary safety fencing area.

### ADDITIONAL NOTES

- All necessary permits have been obtained.
  - Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

## About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
