Summary

On Thursday, August 10, 2023, Metrolinx hosted the second King/Bathurst CLC meeting, in partnership with OTG. Metrolinx and OTG representatives provided attendees with an overview of the Ontario Line subway project, with a specific focus on the planned King/Bathurst station, including overview of what is currently happening at the station as well as the future upcoming plans in the coming months.

Metrolinx initiated the meeting with welcome remarks, introductions, safety message about pedestrian safety, and a land acknowledgement. Some of the content highlights of the presentation included: the overview of the Ontario Line; the King/Bathurst station area map; current activities for the station including fencing and overhead scaffolding; upcoming demolition plans for the area beginning early August; the mitigation of noise and dust; upcoming heritage works for the south side, front-facing façade on King Street West, the dismantling of the West-facing façade, and the heritage work on the north side; the upcoming TTC spot relocations, tree removal between August 10th and 11th; and the expectations of the traffic management plan.

Representatives from Metrolinx and OTG then addressed questions and took feedback from attendees during the meeting.

Summary of Questions/Comments:

- How will the tunneling take place?
- What kind of vibrations will residents feel near the station?
- Is it possible to have a meeting with resident boards in the area on the construction?
- Where will all the construction workers park daily for the four years of construction?
- Is it possible to receive support on coordinating the construction projects in the area between the province, city, and private contractors?

Commitments from Metrolinx:

- Metrolinx stated that tunneling will be one continuous project, beginning at Exhibition station in two parts, beginning in early 2025.
- Metrolinx will arrange a resident board meeting and will email the resident later.
- Metrolinx and OTG to speak to the City of Toronto to see what coordinating efforts can be done for the area.
- Metrolinx recommends that the team to put together an access plan to bring forth to the next meeting.
