


Bridge support works at the Dundas Street Bridge

Expected start date: September 5th, 2023

Expected duration: Three (3) weeks

Hours of work: Monday to Friday, between 7 a.m. - 7 p.m.



What is happening?

- Starting as early as Tuesday, September 5th, temporary bridge supports will be installed at the Dundas Street East Bridge.
- Drilling activities will take place Monday - Friday between 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. for approximately three (3) weeks.
- Drill rigs will be used dig holes into the ground which will then be filled with rebar and concrete to form temporary support structures called caissons.
- These caissons will support the bridge during the reconstruction work that is scheduled for late September 2023.
- This work will take place within the rail corridor; no traffic or pedestrian impacts are expected.

What to expect

- Noise from construction equipment including concrete trucks, piling rigs, and additional support equipment.
- Construction equipment and materials will be properly secured within the work zones.
- Access to and from the work area will be via access roads at Thackeray Street and the south side of Dundas Street East.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Approximately 40 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
