
Utility Installations at Hurontario Street and John Street

Phase 1: Extended work hours on Hurontario Street at John Street from Monday August 28 to Friday September 1, 2023; Daily 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Phase 2: Temporary Road closure of John Street at Hurontario Street from Tuesday September 5 to Wednesday September 20, 2023 including Sundays; Works daily 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.





What work is taking place?

As utility upgrades progress in the area, crews will be installing stormwater, sanitary and watermain infrastructure at John Street and Hurontario Street. The first phase will involve work in the middle of Hurontario Street for extended hours from **Monday August 28 to Friday September 1, 2023**. The work hours are 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.

In the second phase, a portion of John Street East will be closed from **Tuesday September 5 – Wednesday September 20**, **2023**. The work hours are 7 a.m. to 10 p.m, everyday including Sundays. During this closure, there will be no turns permitted from Hurontario Street onto John Street East. There will be no through access from John Street onto Hurontario Street.

Detour access to John Street East will be maintained via Hurontario Street, Kirwin Avenue and Jaguar Valley Drive.

Please note that **emergency vehicle access will not be maintained** during the closure and will use alternative routes. The closure is being implemented so crews will be able to complete the work safely and efficiently while minimizing impacts.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work, so crews will be able to complete this work safely and efficiently.

Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. If you require the most up-to-date information, please reach out to peel@metrolinx.com and our team will provide you with e-updates of this work.

TIMING

- Extended work hours on Hurontario Street from August 28 to September 1, 2023.
- John Street at Hurontario Street will be closed from September 2 to September 20, 2023.
- The work hours in both phases are everyday including weekends, 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Please follow detour and other traffic signs.
- Emergency vehicle access will not be maintained during the closure.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching work zones.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators,

loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TRANSIT DETAILS
