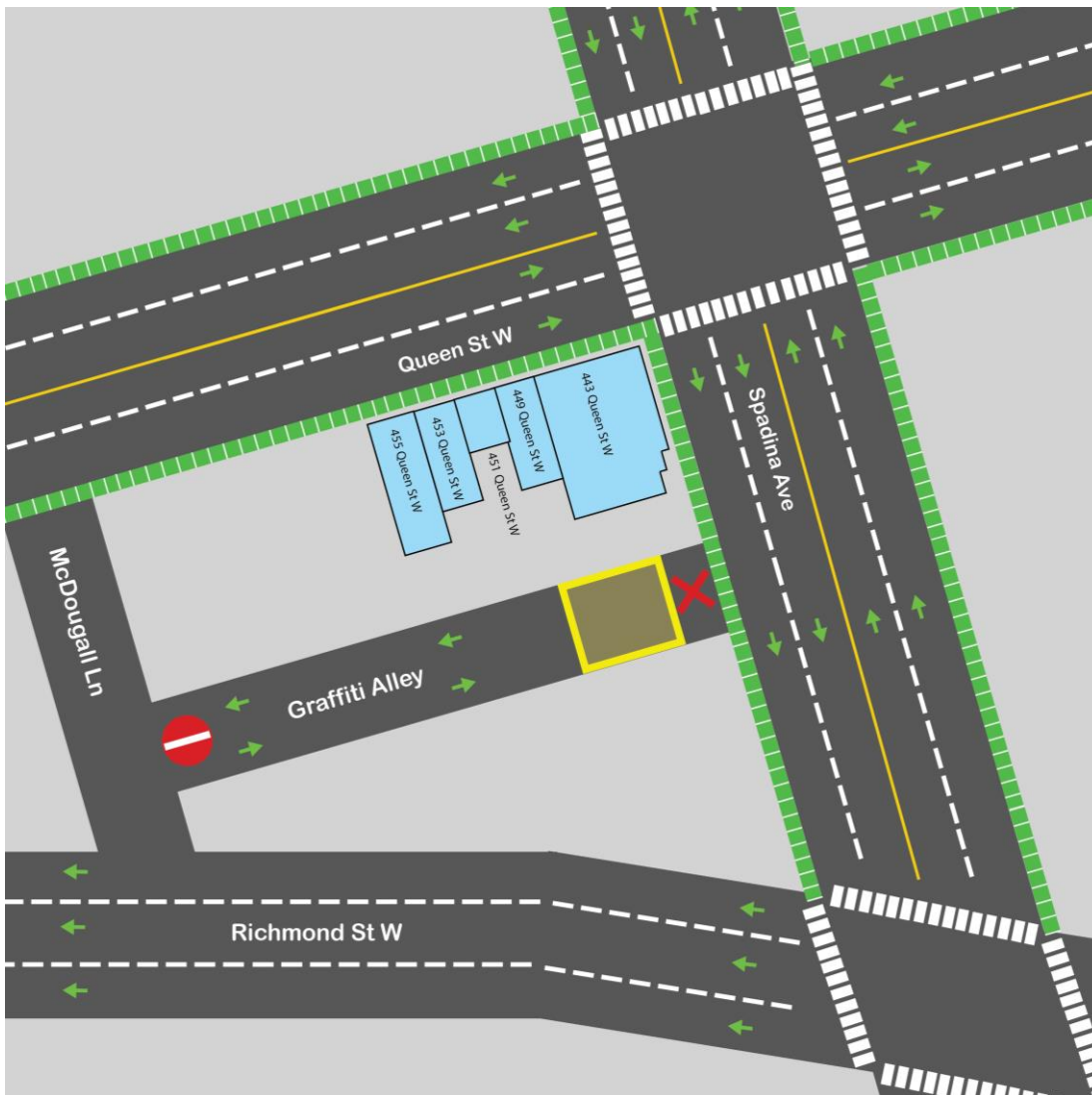


# Notice of telecom utility work near Graffiti Alley

**Expected start date:** as early as September 18, 2023

**Expected completion:** Up to October 18, 2023

**Hours of work:** Monday to Friday 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

## What is happening?

- Removal of old cables and replacement of new telecommunication cables in Graffiti Alley, west of Spadina Ave.
- Telecommunication cable removal and replacement will coincide with excavation activities also taking place in Graffiti Alley.

## When will work begin and how will it impact me?

- The telecom work will begin as early as September 18, 2023. The work will take place over a period of approximately one month.
- All work will be conducted weekdays between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Crews will begin to arrive on site as early as 6 a.m. No overnight or weekend work is currently scheduled.
- Delivery of telecom services provided by Rogers and Bell to adjacent buildings are expected to be impacted while existing cables are removed.
- Access to adjacent buildings may be required by telecommunication providers to ensure service has been restored once work is complete.
- Pedestrians are asked to exercise caution when traveling near active work sites.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to unforeseen weather conditions.
- All the necessary construction permits have been obtained.

## What can I expect?

- Excavation equipment will be present and visible on site.
- Noise and vibration from excavation equipment and activities should be expected.
- Graffiti Alley will only be accessible from McDougall Lane and limited to local traffic only for the duration of the telecom and excavation work. Access to Graffiti Alley from Spadina will be closed during the work period.
- Equipment will be left on site outside of work hours within a fenced area.

## About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
