What is happening?

- In preparation for upcoming construction activities at Moss Park Station, a crew will be drilling boreholes at the locations indicated on the map above to verify the underlying soil characteristics.
- Work will be taking place along Queen Street East and within Moss Park as indicated.
- The work will be overnight from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

What to expect

- The eastbound curb lane on Queen Street will be closed during the intermittent work in this area.
- Sidewalks will remain open.
- Nearby residents and businesses can expect to hear noise related to drilling, hydrovac truck and the use of heavy equipment. Crews will take measures to minimize noise impacts wherever possible.
- Drilling will be intermittent and will not be happening all at once, crews will be moving from spot to spot.
- All the necessary construction permits have been obtained.
- After each shift, the holes will be covered and marked for safety until workers return to continue drilling.
- Construction equipment and materials will be securely kept within the work zones.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen weather conditions or other construction-related impacts.
- As always, please take care when travelling near work sites.
