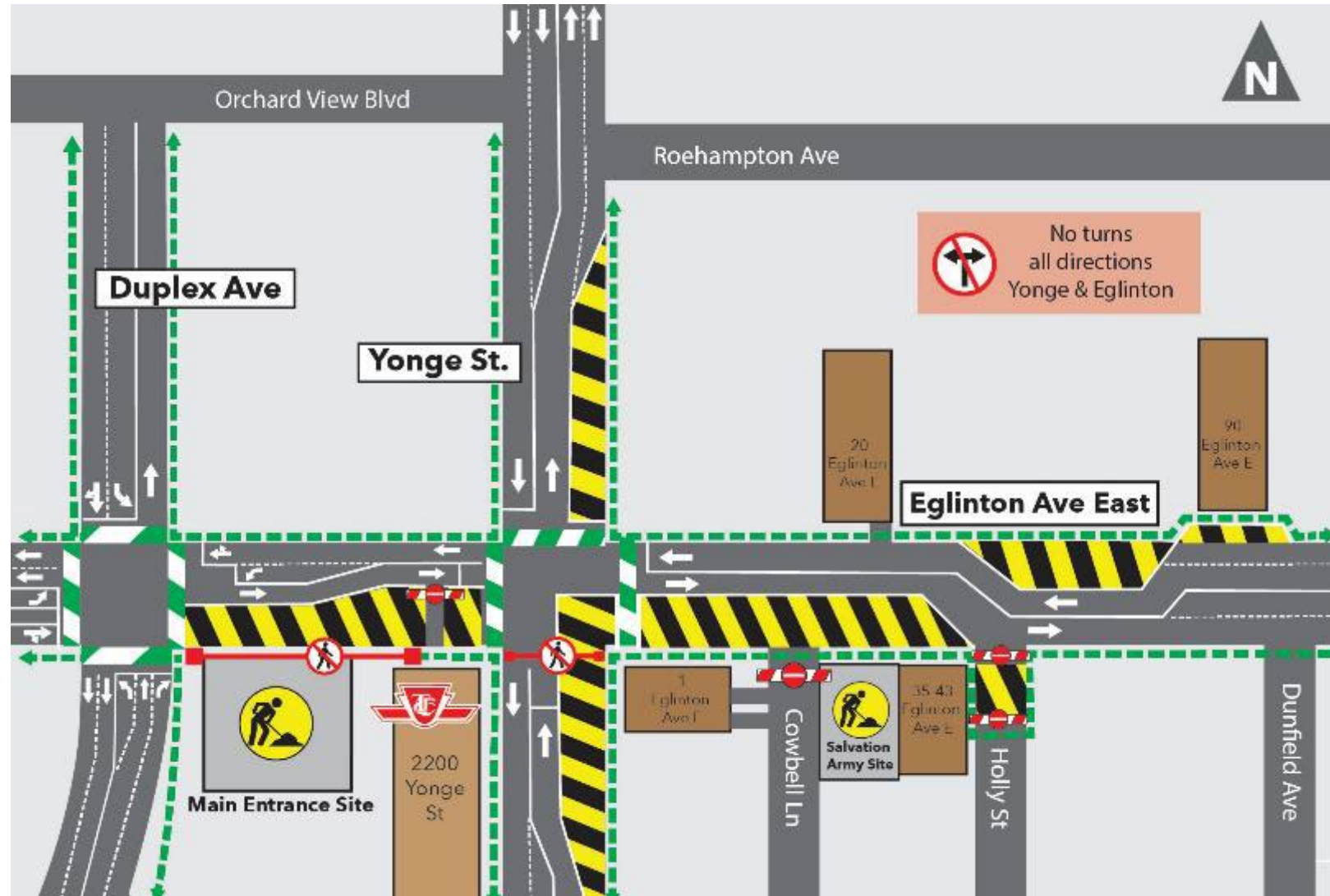

Main Entrance Construction Architectural finishes and mechanical electrical works	South side of Eglinton Ave, west of 2454 Yonge St (BMO Building)	Underway through Fall 2023, landscaping expected to begin in October
TTC Eglinton Station Works Architectural finishes and mechanical electrical works	Eglinton TTC Station	Periodically through Fall 2023, expected major completion in November

UPCOMING OVERNIGHT WORK AND DUPLEX CLOSURE: PHASE ONE

As early as September 25th and ongoing for approximately one (1) week

- Work will be ongoing overnight for 7 days a week between 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Phase One:

- Vehicular access to Duplex Avenue will be restricted at Eglinton Avenue West with the exception of TTC and emergency vehicles.
- For permitted vehicles, one lane of alternating traffic will be maintained by flaggers.
- This road closure will only be in place overnight during work hours.
- Access to Duplex Road at Eglinton Avenue West will be reinstated at the end of each work night and remain opened throughout the daytime.
- Eastbound and westbound left and right turns from Eglinton Avenue West will be restricted at Duplex Avenue.
- Southbound traffic on Duplex Avenue will be reduced to one lane at Eglinton Avenue West.
- Southbound through traffic from Duplex Avenue will be restricted at Eglinton Avenue West.
- The crosswalk on the east side of Eglinton Avenue West and Duplex Avenue will be restricted.
- A Paid Duty Officer will be present while work takes place.



UPCOMING OVERNIGHT WORK AND DUPLEX CLOSURE: PHASE TWO

As early as November 2nd and ongoing for approximately one (1) week

- Work will be ongoing overnight for 7 days a week between 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

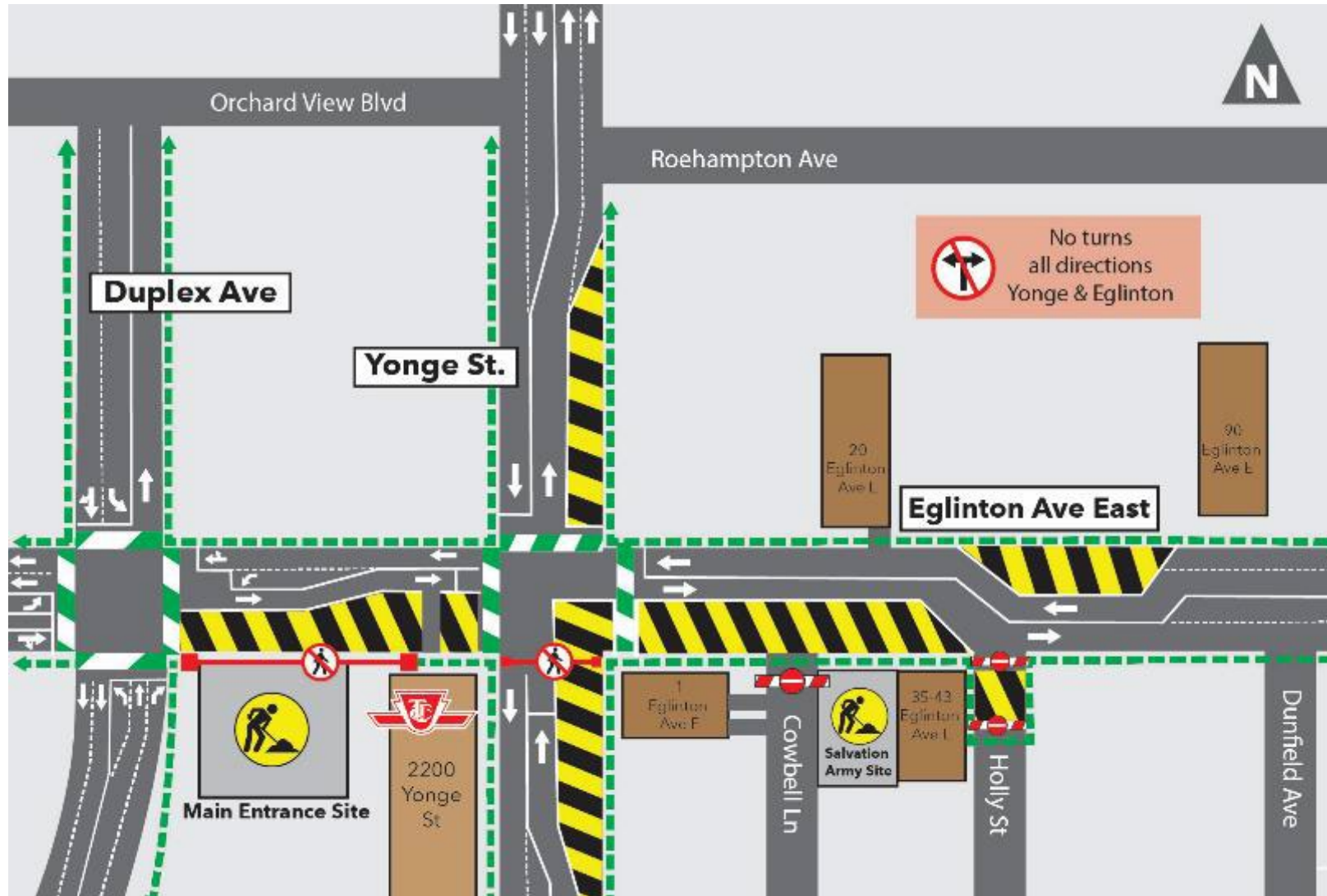
Phase Two:

- Vehicular access to Duplex Avenue will be restricted at Eglinton Avenue West with the exception of TTC and emergency vehicles.
- For permitted vehicles, one lane of alternating traffic will be maintained by flaggers.
- This road closure will only be in place overnight during work hours.
- Access to Duplex Road at Eglinton Avenue West will be reinstated at the end of each work night and remain opened throughout the daytime.
- Eastbound and westbound left and right turns from Eglinton Avenue West will be restricted at Duplex Avenue.
- Two lane of southbound traffic on Duplex Avenue will be reinstated at Eglinton Avenue West.
- Southbound through traffic from Duplex Avenue will be restricted at Eglinton Avenue West.
- The crosswalk on the west side of Eglinton Avenue West and Duplex Avenue will be restricted.
- A Paid Duty Officer will be present while work takes place.

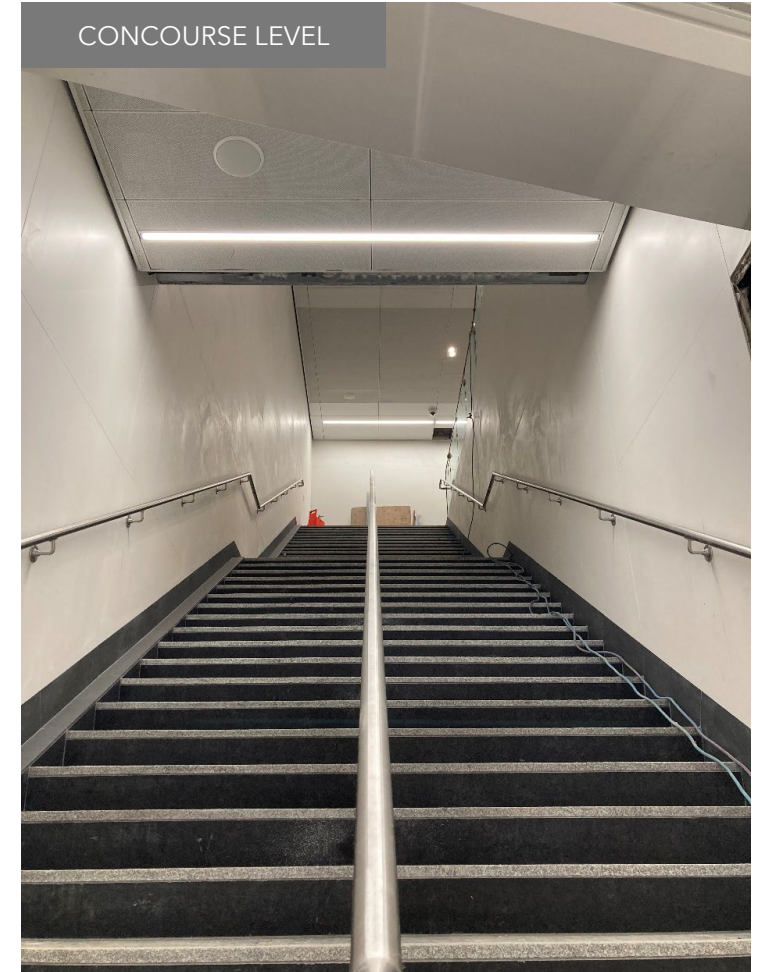
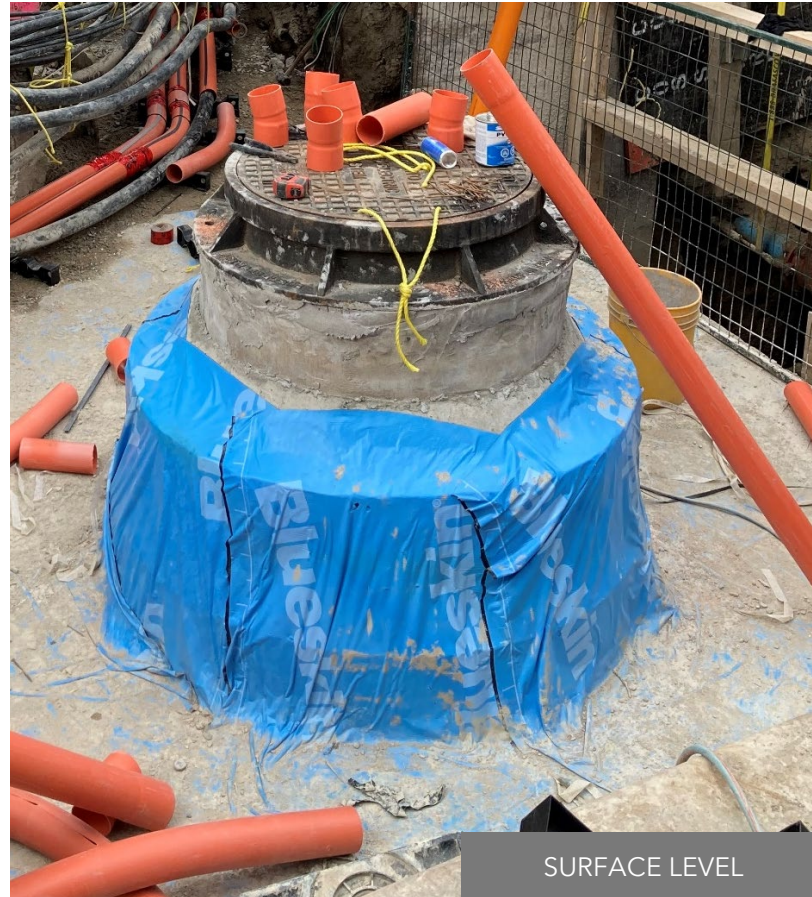

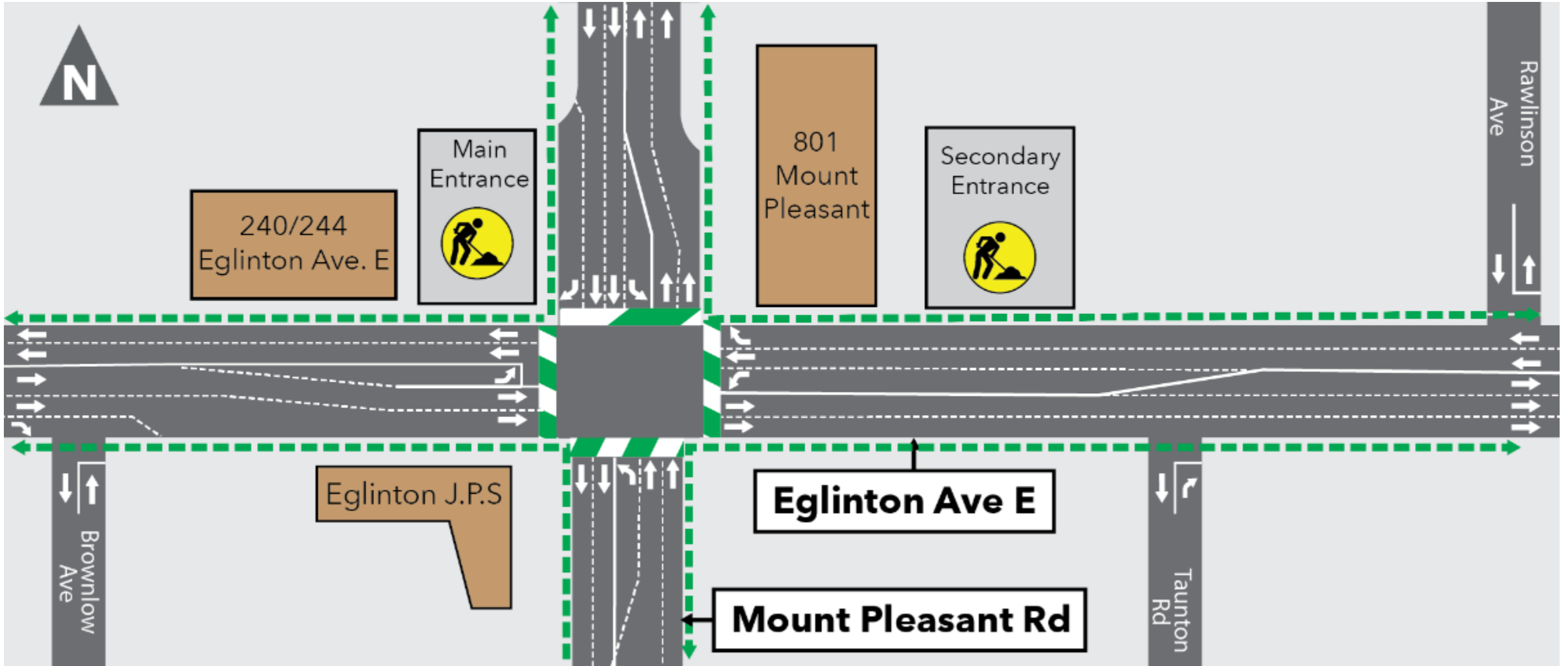
