Lakeshore East GO Expansion: Rail Corridor Vegetation Removal

September 2023

Project Overview

Work is underway to deliver the GO Expansion Program - the largest transit expansion in Canadian history. To allow fast, quiet, electrified, two-way, all-day service that will come with GO Expansion, Metrolinx will build new track, signals, rail facilities and electrification infrastructure, modify and build bridges, and improve crossings across the core segments of the GO rail network. Ongoing vegetation control in and around the rail corridors is essential to operating safe and reliable GO train service. GO Expansion requires an enhanced approach for trees and vegetation to create room for and protect new infrastructure, and to optimize corridor safety. Native trees removed as part of this work will be replaced within the City of Toronto through a compensation program based on the Metrolinx Vegetation Guideline. The program will increase the tree count in the region.

Upcoming Work
