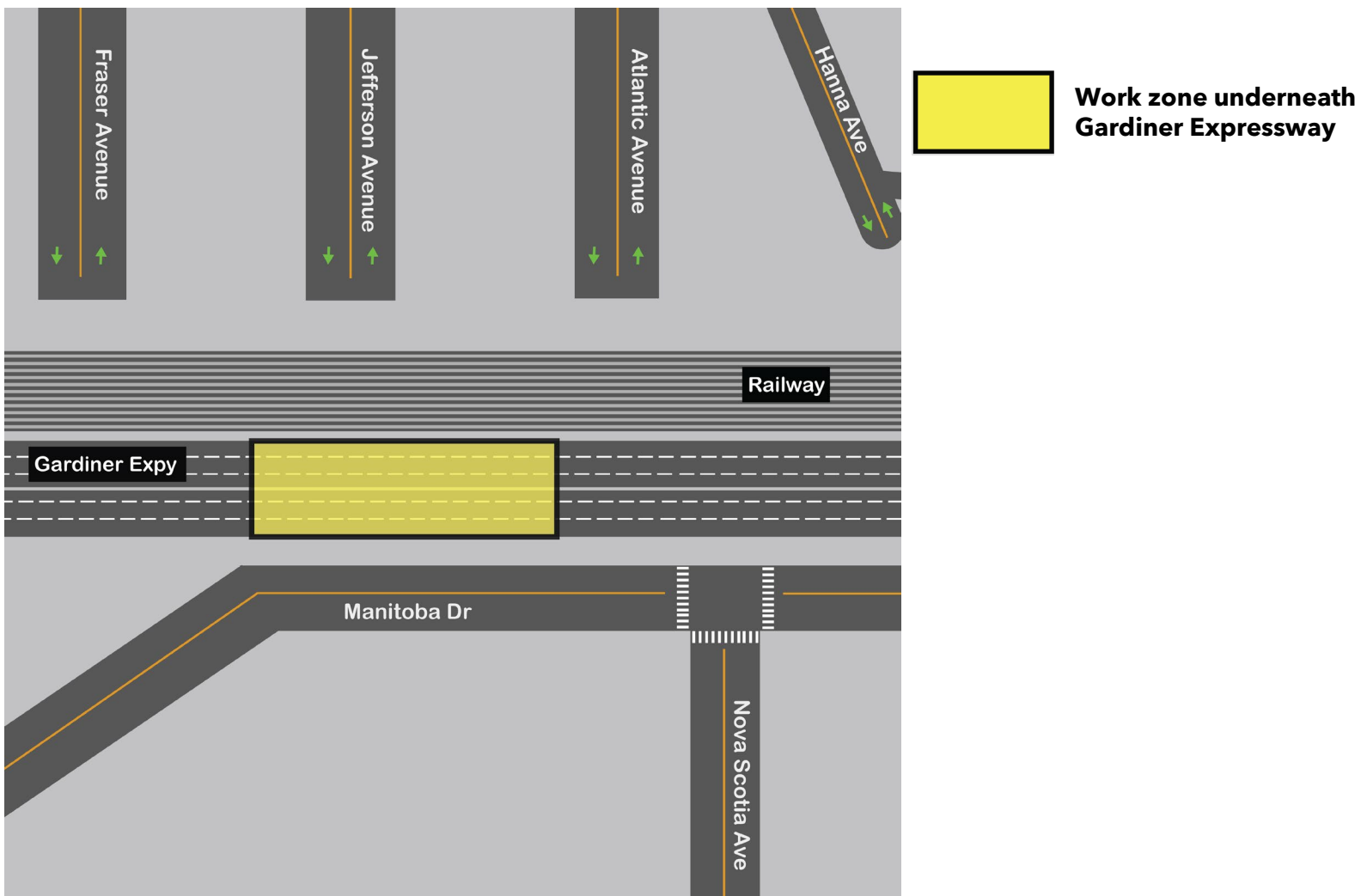


Utility relocation below the Gardiner Expressway

Expected start date: As early as September 22, 2023

Expected completion: Up to 2 months

Hours of work: Weekdays 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

What is happening?

- Work crews will be relocating utilities and other services currently located under the Gardiner Expressway near Exhibition station.

When will work begin and how will it affect me?

- Work will begin as early as Friday, September 22, 2023 and take place over a period of up to two (2) months.
- Work will be conducted weekdays between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Work crews will begin to arrive on site as early as 6 a.m.
- Given the work area, there are no planned closures or diversions for either pedestrian or vehicle traffic in the area.

What can I expect?

- Residents can expect to hear noise from work equipment, such as a hydrovac truck or other heavy equipment.
- There are no planned closures or diversions, however the work area will be fenced off to prevent trespassing on site.
- Work may be delayed, rescheduled, or extended due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
- All the necessary permits have been obtained.

About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer car trips each day.
