
Updated: Landscaping Works on Eglinton Avenue East between Brentcliffe Road and Leslie Street

Mid-October 2023



What Work is Taking Place?

As early as mid-October 2023, crews will begin landscaping restoration activities on the north side of Eglinton Avenue East, east of Brentcliffe Road. To facilitate this work safely, westbound traffic on Eglinton Avenue East may be periodically reduced to one through lane between Brentcliffe Road and Leslie Street. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times. Landscaping restoration activities include planting approximately sixty-four (64) trees (including a mixture of Common Hackberry, Bur Oak, Silver Maple, Bitternut Hickory, Red Oak, Black Cherry, Eastern White Pine, Kentucky Coffee, and Trembing Aspen trees), and numerous shrubs and plants (including a mixture of Snowberry, Buffaloberry, Fragrant Sumac, Staghorn Sumac, Chokecherry, Sandbar Willow, Nannyberry, and Fire Cherry). This work is expected to take place on Monday -

Friday, between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. for approximately six (6) weeks. Upon completion of this work, short term lane reductions may be required to facilitate special activities.

What to Expect

Landscaping restoration activities include planting approximately sixty-four (64) trees (including a mixture of Common Hackberry, Bur Oak, Silver Maple, Bitternut Hickory, Red Oak, Black Cherry, Eastern White Pine, Kentucky Coffee, and Trembing Aspen trees), and numerous shrubs and plants (including a mixture of Snowberry, Fragrant Sumac, Staghorn Sumac, Chokecherry, Sandbar Willow, Nannyberry, and Fire Cherry).

HOURS OF WORK

- As early as mid-October 2023, for approximately six (6) weeks.
- This work is expected to take place on Monday Friday, between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- This work may be rescheduled or delayed due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
- Work may be longer or shorter than expected.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- To facilitate this work safely, westbound traffic on Eglinton Avenue East may be periodically reduced to one through lane between Brentcliffe Road and Leslie Street.
- One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

No changes to the current pedestrian routes are expected as a result of this work.
