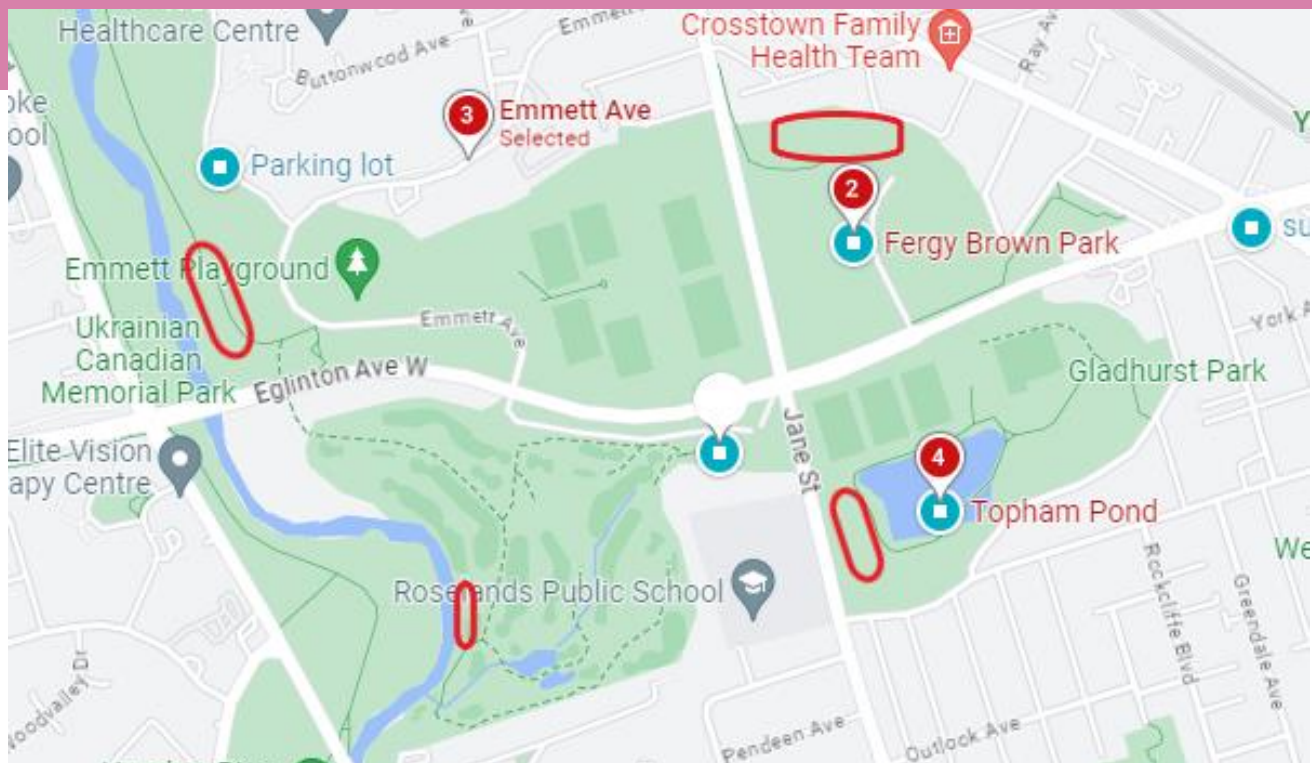


Bat habitat structure installation

Scheduled start: October 5, 2023 to October 16, 2023

What is happening?

- Staff from the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority under contract to Metrolinx will be installing bat box habitat structures in areas of the Mount Dennis community marked in red on the map above.
- The habitat structures will provide a safe environment for the local bat population.
- Work to install the bat boxes will be happening in the area of Scarlett Woods Golf Course, the Humber River Trail, Topham Pond and Fergy Brown Park.

About the project

- The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension will bring even more rapid transit to Etobicoke and Mississauga, making it easier for people to get where they need to be each day.
- The extension of the Eglinton Crosstown LRT will run 9.2 kilometers from the Mount Dennis station to Renforth Drive and will operate mainly underground. Once complete, it will create a continuous rapid transit line that stretches from Scarborough, through midtown Toronto, and into Mississauga.

What to expect

- Crews may use augers and skid steer loaders to assist with the installation of the bat boxes in parks and nearby natural habitats.
- Traffic and pedestrian access will not be impacted.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
