
Geotechnical Investigative Work within the Lakeshore West Corridor

October 16, 2023



Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.



What You Need to Know

As part of investigative work for the GO Expansion On-Corridor Works project, crews will be installing survey monuments by excavating and drilling at designated locations within the rail corridor. Survey monuments will help determine elevation benchmarks, track rail movements, and assess ground conditions within the Lakeshore West rail corridor. This work will support future track and infrastructure updates.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Crews will drill and install pre-cast concrete survey monuments using a boom truck and excavator with an auger attachment. The installation will be followed by pouring of lean concrete and backfilling gravel.
- Brass cap and steel Survipod survey monuments will be used and installed throughout the corridor.
- In advance of drilling and excavation, crews are required to clear a path at designated locations. This may involve removal of grass, shrubs and low-lying vegetation to properly mark survey monument locations.
- A vac-truck may be used at certain locations to identify utilities in advance of drilling.
- Residents may experience some noise and minor vibration from the drill and other construction vehicles or equipment.
- Noise and vibration monitoring will take place and mitigation measures will be applied as required.
- Work will take place within the rail corridor.
- Site lighting will be pointed away from residences.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work is expected to take place overnight, when there is minimal train activity from Thursday to Sunday from approximately 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., beginning October 16, 2023.
- Work will progress in stages within the area highlighted on the map for approximately four weeks.
