

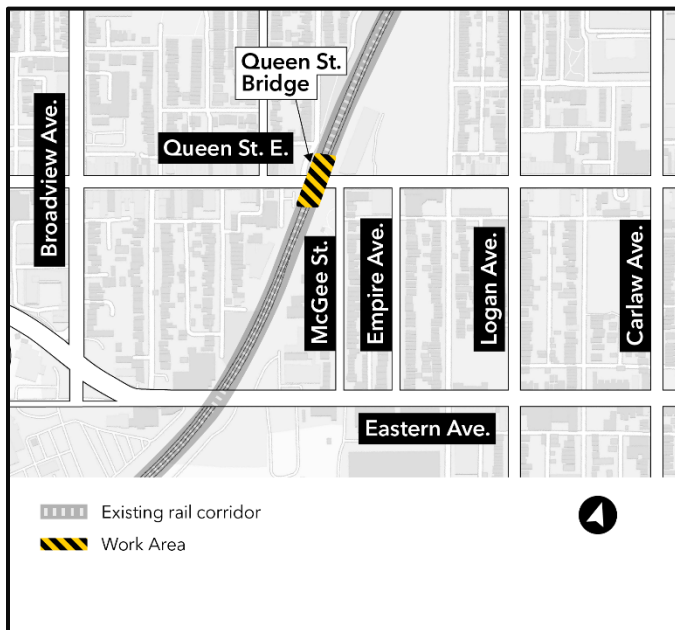
Structural support works at the Queen Street East bridge

Expected start date: Thursday, October 12, 2023

Expected duration: Two (2) months

Hours of work: Monday to Friday, between 7 a.m. - 7 p.m.

Weekend work: Friday October 13 - Monday October 16, 2023, between 7 a.m. - 11 p.m.



What is happening?

- Starting as early as Thursday October 12, 2023, structural support works will begin at the Queen Street East bridge.
- This work will take place between 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. through late November 2023.
- **Weekend work will be required from Friday October 13 - Monday October 16, 2023, between 7 a.m. - 11 p.m. to complete pile installations at the Queen Street East bridge.**

- The Lakeshore East rail corridor will be shut down from Friday October 13 – Monday October 16, 2023, to complete piling works at the Queen Street East bridge. Please review the “transit information” section below for further details.
- This work will take place from within the rail corridor; no traffic or pedestrian impacts are expected.

What to expect

- Pile drill rigs will be used dig holes into the ground which will then be filled with rebar and concrete to form temporary support structures called caissons.
- Once the caissons are installed, excavation and shoring works will take place on the east side of the Queen Street East bridge.
- Noise from construction equipment including concrete trucks, pile drill rigs, excavators, loaders, saws, and other heavy machinery can be expected.
- Construction equipment and materials will be properly secured within the work zones.
- Construction equipment will use the access roads at Thackeray Street and Queen Street East to enter and exit the work area (rail corridor).
- Once these structural support works are completed, crews will begin to remove and rebuild the bridge piers and abutments.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

Transit information

- There will be no GO train service on the Lakeshore East Line starting the evening of Friday, October 13 until the end of service on Sunday October 15, 2023.
- Buses will replace some train services during this time. For more information on GO service impacts, please visit the GO website.
- On Monday, October 16, 2023, train service will only be offered between Durham College Oshawa GO to Danforth GO stations. There will be no train service to Union Station.

About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Approximately 40 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
