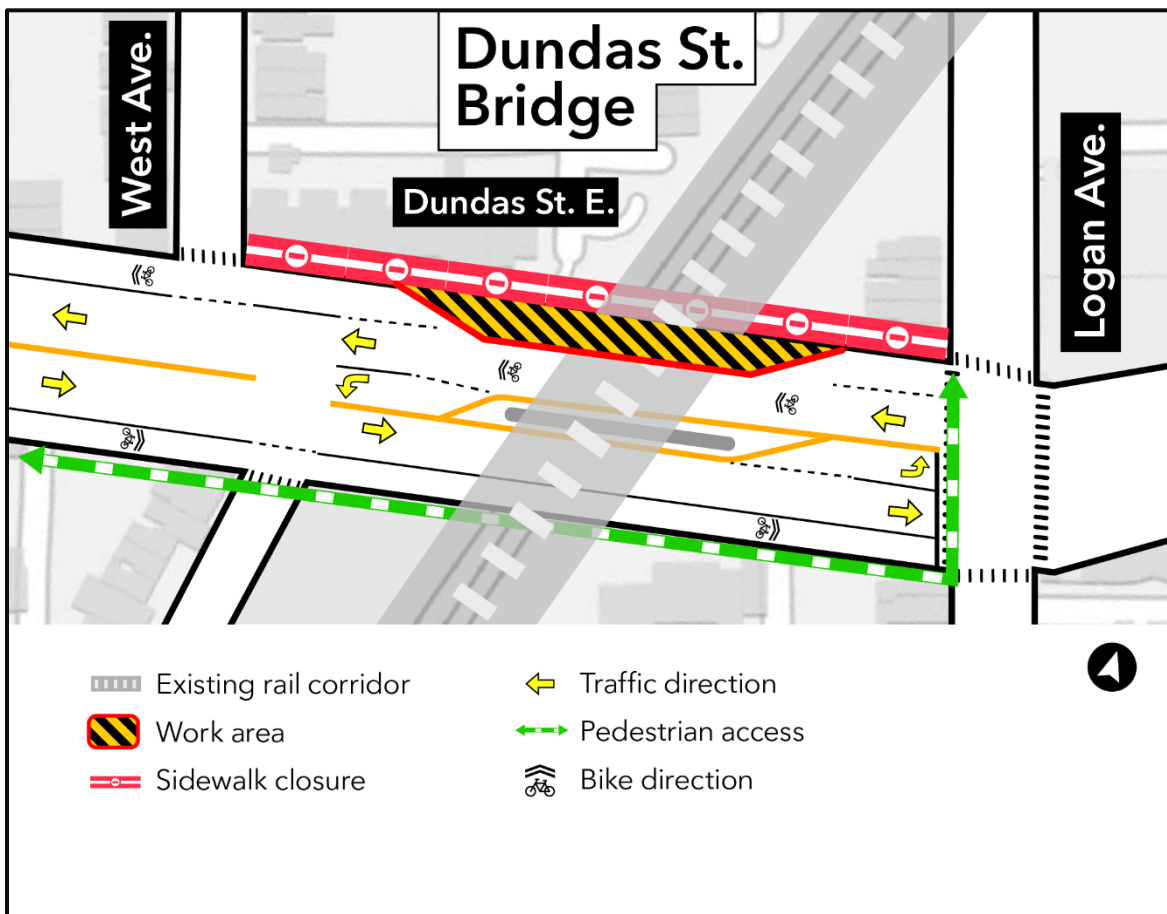


Utility relocation work on Dundas Street East

Expected start date: Wednesday, October 25, 2023

Expected duration: Five (5) weeks

Hours of work: Monday - Friday, between 7 a.m. - 7 p.m.



What is happening?

- Starting as early as Wednesday, October 25, 2023, utility relocation work will begin on Dundas Street East between Logan Avenue and Wardell Street.
- This work will take place on weekdays, Monday to Friday, between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. for approximately five (5) weeks.

- Temporary traffic, bike lane, and sidewalk closures will be required to safely perform these activities; please refer to the traffic and pedestrian details below for specific information.

Traffic and pedestrian details

- The westbound bike lane on Dundas Street East will be closed during this work. Westbound cyclists will need to share the road with vehicles while travelling through this area. Share the road signs will be posted to guide cyclists.
- Motorists are reminded to slow down and allow cyclists to safely merge into the traffic lane. Do not attempt to pass cyclists.
- The sidewalk on the north side of Dundas Street East will be closed periodically between Logan Avenue and Wardell Street. One sidewalk will remain open at all times.

What to expect

- Noise from construction equipment including hydro-vacuum trucks, road saws, loaders, excavators, and construction delivery trucks.
- The existing overhead utility cables on the south side of Dundas Street East will be relocated underground to enable important transit upgrades in the Lakeshore East rail corridor.
- Advance signage will be in place to direct vehicles, pedestrians, and cyclists.
- Traffic barrels, fencing, and barriers will be in place to separate and secure work zones.
- Construction equipment and materials will be properly secured within the work zones.
- Traffic control personnel will be present while this work takes place.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Approximately 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
