<u>Summary</u>

On Tuesday, August 22, 2023, Metrolinx hosted the Pape Avenue CLC (Construction Liaison Committee #7). The meeting was held virtually. Metrolinx presented the following details:

- Upcoming/ongoing construction work (Enbridge and Bell utility relocations)
- Long-term noise barrier design and installation schedule
- Outdoor air quality monitoring additional location

Metrolinx' team of subject matter experts and presenters addressed concerns and took feedback from the group.

Summary of Questions/Comments:

- 1. Community members shared concerns around site cleanliness and debris left onsite.
- 2. Residents had concerns about the flaggers on the Enbridge site- confusion and safety.
- 3. How long will the noise wall be in the area? Why will monitors be removed in January 2024?
- 4. What is the plan for children's participation in the mural design?
- 5. Residents alluded to Metrolinx' commitment to hosting a noise workshop and requested for an audiologist to be in attendance.

- 6. What is Metrolinx' plan for security since street visibility will be reduced after the noise wall is installed?
- 7. Resident pointed out that Metrolinx committed to replacing soil removed with clean soil, yet soil was reused along Langley.
- 8. Why Mx did not follow commitment to dispose of all excavated soil at the school?
- 9. What level of decibel reduction will the noise wall offer?
- 10. When will the updated Health and Safety Plan be ready?

Action Items

- 1. Mx to follow up with noise expert to confirm Mx's position on TDSB's noise recommendations.
- 2. Mx to take back request for audiologist to attend noise workshop to be held late September.
- 3. Mx to follow up with Bell about removing remaining materials from Pape and Langley.
- 4. Mx to take back community's safety concerns about flagging operations during Enbridge Phase 1 work
- 5. Design and timelines for school's mural input to be discussed with TDSB in the coming weeks.
- 6. Mx to produce process for streamlining responses to safety concerns at Pape School.
- 7. Mx to take back potential security concerns in school playground resulting from noise wall.
- 8. Mx to procure clearer contact signage for sites near the Pape Avenue Junior Public School.
- 9. Mx to explore communications initiatives to coordinate activities and inform school about construction.
