

# Lower Jarvis Street Sidewalk Impacts and Evening Work

November 2023 - January 2024



## What is happening?

Beginning as early as November 13th and continuing into the new year, there will be increased construction activity at street level, south of the Lower Jarvis Street rail corridor bridge. A crane pad will be installed just south of the tracks and will support the upcoming bridge extension construction work. This work will involve excavator and vacuum truck deployment.

To facilitate this needed work, the west and east sidewalks along Lower Jarvis Street from Lakeshore Boulevard to just north of the rail bridge will experience alternating closures, with one sidewalk fully open at all times. The west side will be closed first for a period of approximately 4 weeks followed by the east side. Directional signage will be used to assist pedestrians through this area.

Please note, that access to the Crombie Park and Cathedral Court communities will remain open during this construction period. We appreciate your ongoing patience and understanding of this necessary work. Date subject to change.
