

# Fencing installation at Queen and University

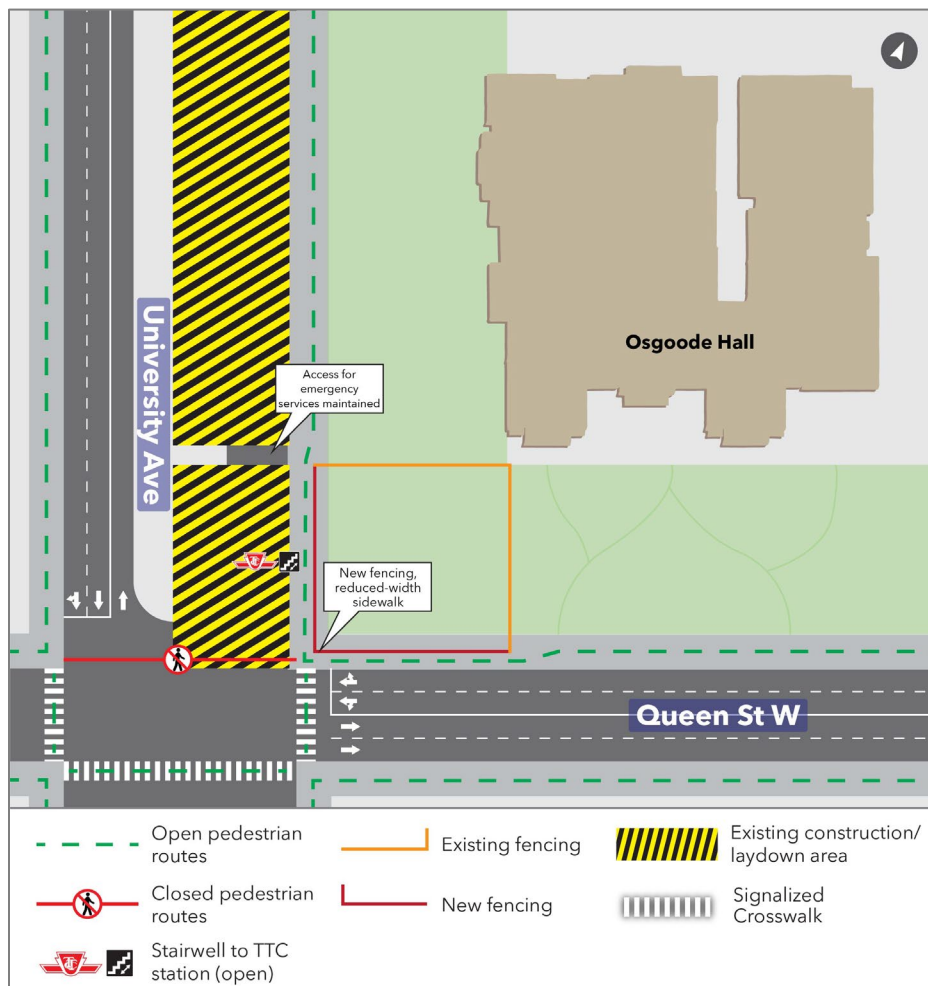
**Expected start date:** As early as October 30, 2023

**Expected duration to install:** 1 night

**Expected duration of fencing:** Up to March 30, 2024

**Hours of work:** Overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

## What is happening?

- To prepare for construction activities for the future Ontario Line Osgoode Station, crews will be installing a temporary metal fence along the exterior perimeter of the existing heritage fencing at the Osgoode Hall corner.

- Work is expected to begin as early as October 30, 2023, and will take one night to install. Crews will be working between the hours of 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. to minimize pedestrian impact and ensure safety.
- The fence is expected to be in place until at least March 30, 2024, and may be reconfigured as a part of future activities.

## What to expect

- The width of a portion of the north sidewalk on Queen Street West and east sidewalk on University Avenue will be reduced due to the fence. Pedestrians will have approximately 2 metres of sidewalk to continue traveling in all directions.
- Nearby residents should expect to see a delivery truck and fencing being unloaded, as well as crews installing the fence.
- Minimal noise is expected related to this work.
- Clear directional signage will be posted.
- Work crews will safely direct pedestrians when the fence is being unloaded from delivery trucks.
- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.
- Work may be delayed, rescheduled or extended due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
