

Temporary Driveway Closures on Hurontario from Mineola Road East to Pinewood Trail

Beginning November 16th to December 18th, 2023



What work is taking place?

With the recent installation of new hydro poles as a part of the Hazel McCallion LRT project, we will be doing aerial conductor stringing and cable pulling works between Mineola Road East and Pinewood Trail on the east side of Hurontario Street. These works are scheduled to take place from November 16th to December 18th, 2023. To safely accommodate these works, driveways for properties within this stretch will be intermittently impacted for up to one hour each, between 7 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Thursday. This works will not occur on Fridays and weekends.

Please note that this does not require any open cut excavation on impacted driveways. Cable mounting trucks will be parked at each new hydro pole installed, and crews will be working from pole to pole between these two intersections. To accommodate motorists needing to enter and exit driveways impacted during working hours, a flag person will be present to help as needed. The sidewalk between Mineola and Pinewood will also be impacted during this activity. Please adhere to all detour signage.

TIMING

- Work is scheduled to start on November 16th, 2023, and finish by December 18th, 2023.
- Work involving driveway closures will generally occur between 7 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday to Thursday. There will be no Friday or weekend work for these activities.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Lane reductions will be required on Hurontario Street.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- MiWay will continue to operate with regular service.
- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.
- Visit www.miway.ca/updates for updates on your bus route.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Sidewalk access along the east side of Hurontario Street, between Mineola Road East and Pinewood Trail will be affected.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians & cyclists as detours will be required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

PROPERTY DETAILS

- Crews will not require access to private property. All works will take place within the public right of way.
- For details on your property boundaries, please refer to your land survey, or consult an Ontario Land Surveyor.
- Driveways are expected to be intermittently impacted for up to one hour each, between the hours of 7 a.m. and 4 p.m., as crews work from pole to pole between Mineola Road East and Pinewood Trail.
