King/Bathurst Construction site emergency drill

Expected start date: As early as November 22, 2023

Time of drill: 9:30 a.m.

Duration: Less than 15 minutes for the duration of the drill

What is happening?

- As a major component of our commitment to safety, crews will be conducting an emergency drill at the future King-Bathurst station site.
- A 5-10 second loud, emergency horn blast will occur at 9:30am, followed by 3 short blasts, on Wednesday, November 22, 2023.
- City of Toronto emergency services have been notified of this event and are aware that it is a drill.
- This is a temporary pause in work, and normal activities will resume once complete.

What to expect

- Loud, emergency horn blast will be occurring at 9:30am, for roughly 5-10 seconds, as part of the emergency drill. 3 short blasts will promptly follow, indicating the sites are safe and clear.
- This is a controlled event, and the horn blast is a test of the emergency system.
- Crews will temporarily pause their duties to gather at designated muster points at 668 King Street W, along the east side of Bathurst Street, as well as 60 Stewart Street
- Normal construction work will resume upon completion of the drill.
