EGLINTON CROSSTOWN LRT

Streets and intersections continuing to re-open as progress is made toward reaching substantial completion.





FINCH WEST LRT

Mechanical, electrical, and plumbing work as well as work on interior finishes nearing completion at Humber College Station.



ONTARIO LINE

Major track closures enabling critical early construction work across various bridges in Toronto's east end.

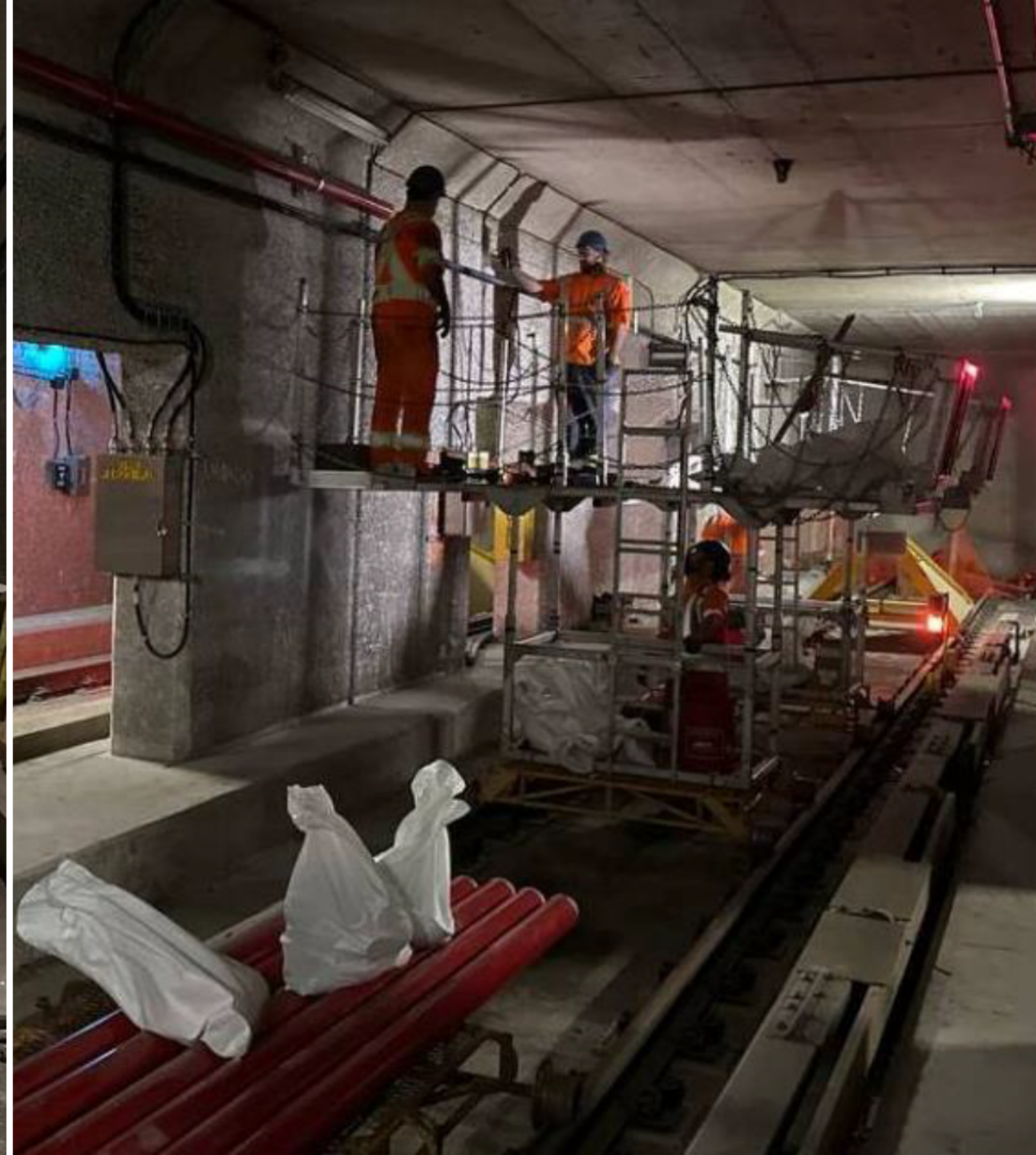
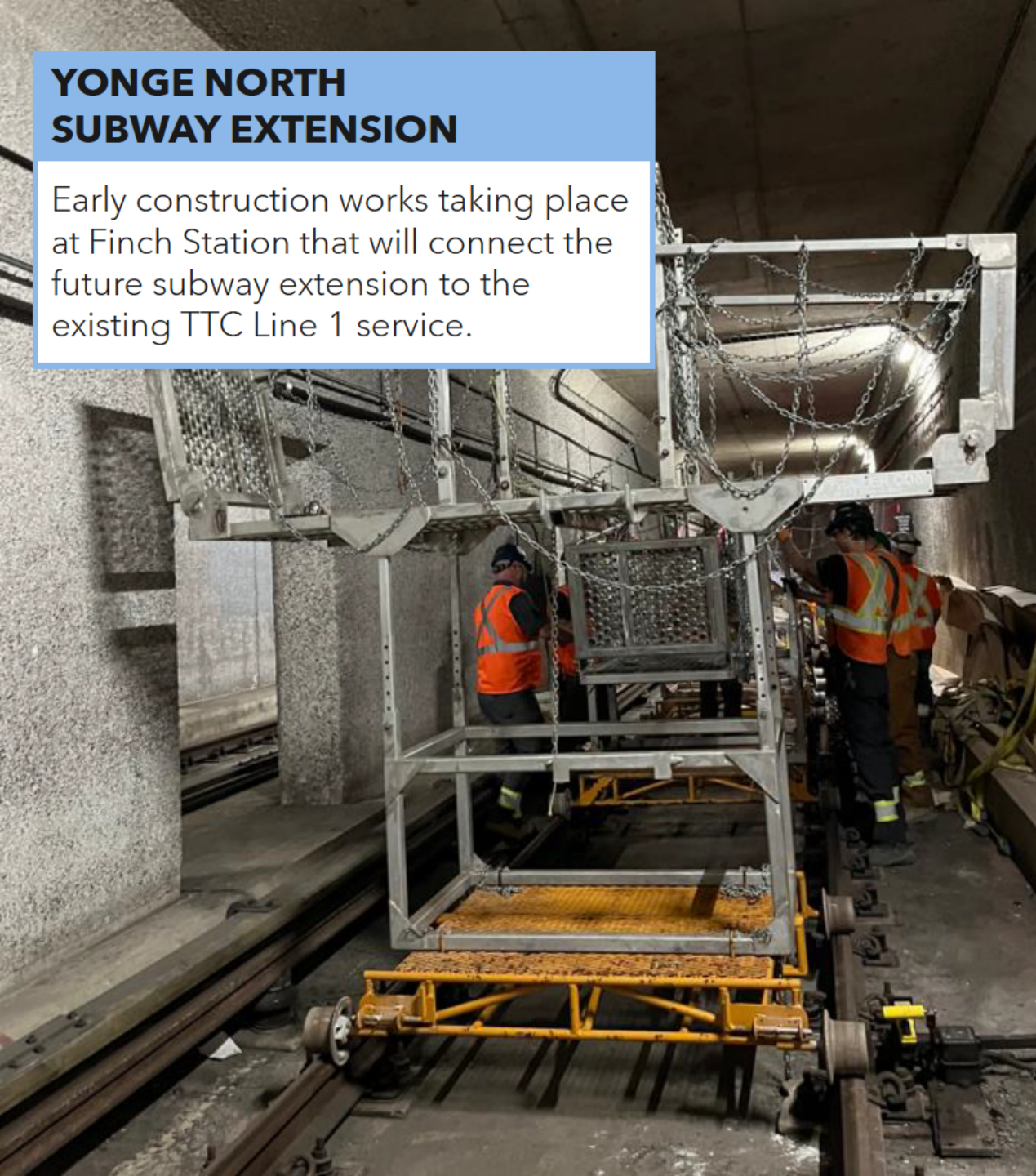
HAZEL MCCALLION LINE

Finishing corridor works at Port Credit Station, which marks the end of mandatory train speed decrease while passing through this station.



YONGE NORTH SUBWAY EXTENSION

Early construction works taking place at Finch Station that will connect the future subway extension to the existing TTC Line 1 service.



SCARBOROUGH SUBWAY EXTENSION

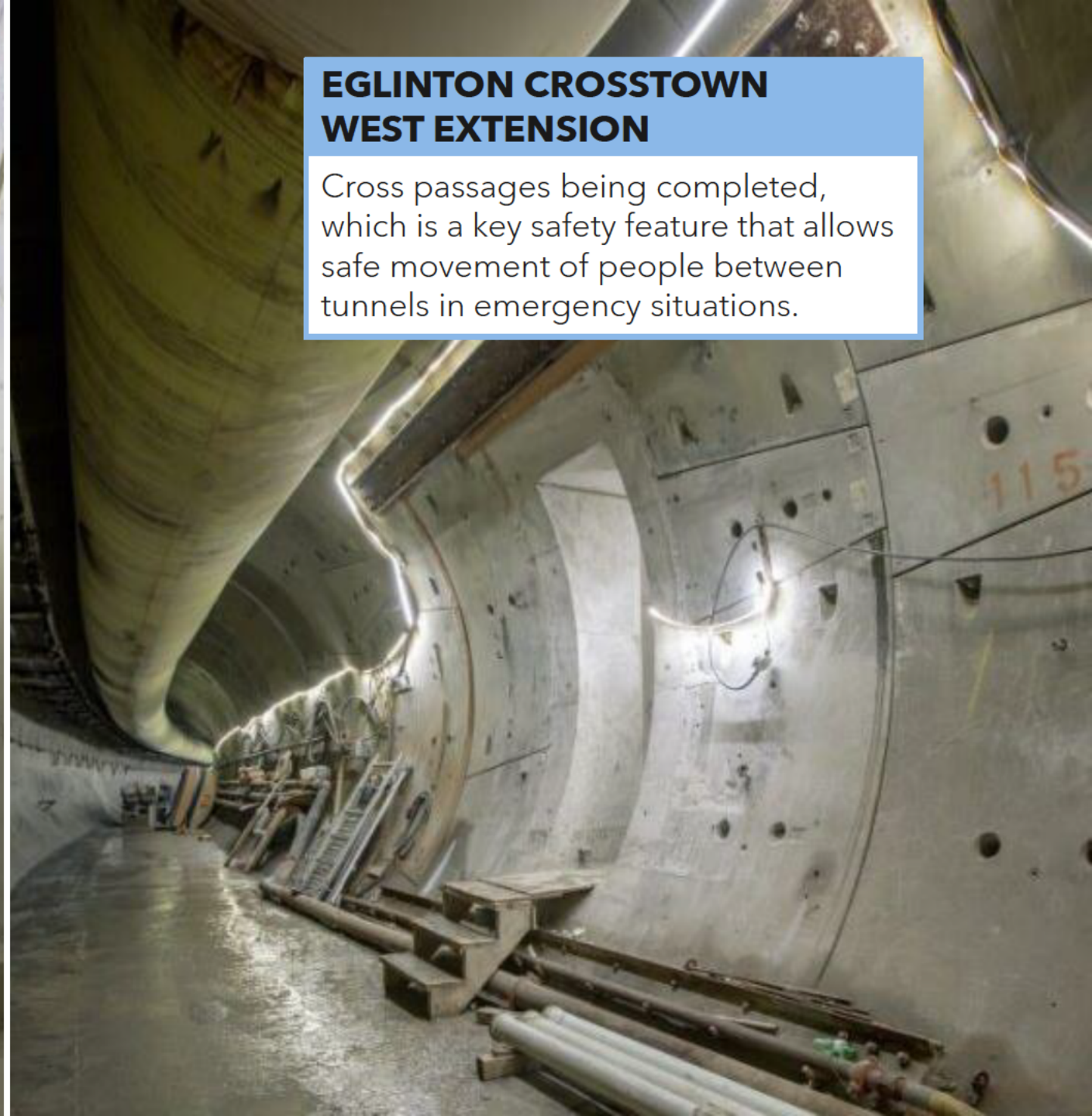
Road diversion at Eglinton and Midland Avenue complete that will enable construction of future extraction shaft for the tunnel boring machine.



HAMILTON LRT

Commencement of enabling works, including utility relocations that will help prepare for future Hamilton LRT construction.





EGLINTON CROSSTOWN WEST EXTENSION

Cross passages being completed, which is a key safety feature that allows safe movement of people between tunnels in emergency situations.
