

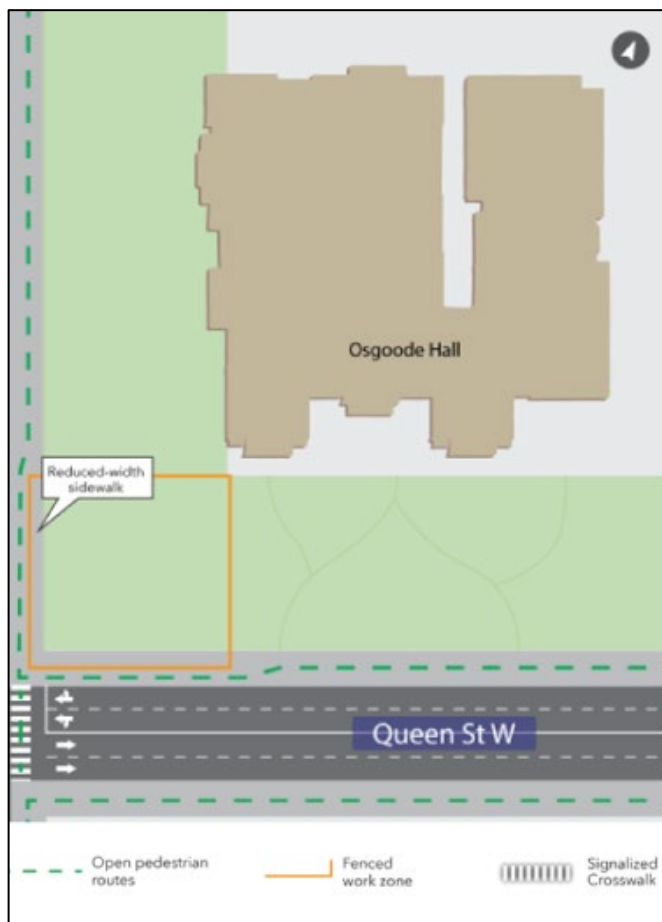
Overnight soil testing at Queen Street West and University Avenue

Expected start date: As early as November 27, 2023

Expected duration: up to 30 days

Hours of work: Overnight, Monday to Friday from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

What is happening?

- In preparation for upcoming construction of the future Osgoode Station, crews will be drilling one borehole within the fenced construction area highlighted above.
- Borehole investigation is done to verify underlying soil conditions.
- Work is expected to begin as early as November 27, 2023 and will take up to 30 days to complete due to the angle and depth (64 metres) of the borehole required.
- Crews will be working overnight from Monday to Friday weekdays between the hours of 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

What to expect

- Those nearby can expect to hear noise related to the borehole drilling, including the use of equipment such as drill rigs.
- Any equipment left on site will be safely secured.
- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.
- Work may be delayed, rescheduled, or extended due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
