#### **Land Acknowledgement**

# Construction Updates


#### **Enbridge Gas Relocation Phase 2 and Bell Summary**

#### Phase 2

- Enbridge Gas started work on November 20, 2023, to relocate a gas line on the east side of Pape Avenue.
- Construction activities include:
  - open trench excavation
  - installation of new gas line
  - energization of the new gas line
- The work is planned to be completed in mid-December.


#### **Bell Stage 2**

- Bell will be pausing cable pull work and resuming once the Enbridge relocation work has been completed.
- Work will continue until February 2024 on an intermittent basis.



#### **Upcoming THESL Work**

- Toronto Hydro's existing duct bank along Pape Ave between Riverdale and Langley will be relocated to allow for the storm sewer relocation.
- Work will be paused during school drop-off (8:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.) and pick-up times (3:10 p.m. to 3:45 p.m.).
- All required permits have been received and work is expected to start in January 2024.
- Construction activities will include:
  - Sidewalk and road pavement cutting
  - o Chamber rebuild
  - Directional drill work
- Equipment that will be used:
  - Saw cutting
  - Jack-hammers
  - Excavators
  - Hydrovac
  - Materials delivered by truck
- Additional details will be shared as soon as they are available.


#### **Pape School Noise Barrier - Updates**

#### **Construction:**

- Construction will start once Enbridge work is completed.,
- Work is anticipated to begin December 18th.
- The expected duration to complete the work is 1.5 months.

#### Mural:


- Metrolinx finalizing the mural proposal
- School will be engaged once a partner is selected
- Students will be part of the mural creation



## Sewer Relocation

#### **Sewer Relocation Update**

- A new storm sewer from Riverdale Ave to Langley Ave will be installed by microtunneling beneath the school property.
- Contractor is expected to be retained in February 2024.
- Work is anticipated to start in May 2024.
- Detailed information will be provided to the CLC and the community in the new year, including safety, construction and traffic management plans.

#### Action Log - Items discussed during October 24, 2023, CLC


Action Item	Response/Resolution
Metrolinx to take back request for audiologist to attend noise workshop to be held in October.	Audiologist from Speech-Language and Audiology Canada declined to participate in the noise workshop. Advised their area of expertise is not within scope of determining appropriate sound levels - that is best suited for a sound expert.
Metrolinx to schedule a noise workshop with CLC members.	Virtual noise workshop scheduled for December 12, 2023, from 7 p.m 8 p.m.
Metrolinx to take back the community's safety concerns about flagging operations during Enbridge Phase 1 work.	Enbridge has 10 traffic control people on site daily for Phase 2 work.
