


Headwall work at Russell Road and Eglinton Avenue West

Scheduled start: November 23, 2023

Expected completion: December 2023

Construction hours: 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., occasional overnight work as required

What is happening?

- WestEnd Connectors Construction, working on behalf of Metrolinx, will be constructing headwalls at the intersection of Russell Road and Eglinton Avenue West.
- The first headwall on the south side of Eglinton Avenue West is completed.
 Construction will begin on the north side of Eglinton Avenue West to complete the second headwall.
- The additional headwalls are being built to support required maintenance work on the tunnel boring machines.

What to expect

- Nearby residents can expect to hear noise from equipment, such as drilling, compaction equipment, hauling trucks, excavators, dozers, and generators.
- Traffic signage will be provided during construction.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
- Weekend or overnight work may be required. Residents will be provided with updates as they are available.
- The information provided is anticipated based on the current construction schedule and is subject to change.

About the project

- The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension will bring even more rapid transit to Etobicoke and Mississauga, making it easier for people to get where they need to be each day.
- The extension of the Eglinton Crosstown LRT will run 9.2 kilometres from the Mount Dennis station to Renforth Drive and will operate mainly underground. Once complete, it will create a continuous rapid transit line that stretches from Scarborough, through midtown Toronto, and into Mississauga.

Traffic and pedestrian impacts

- Lane closures to the west of Russell Road will be shifted from the south side of Eglinton Avenue West to the north side of the street starting on November 23.
- One lane will be reduced in both directions.
 One eastbound and westbound lane will remain open at all times.
- We are working with the City of Toronto to ensure minimal impact to pedestrians and cyclists during construction.
