

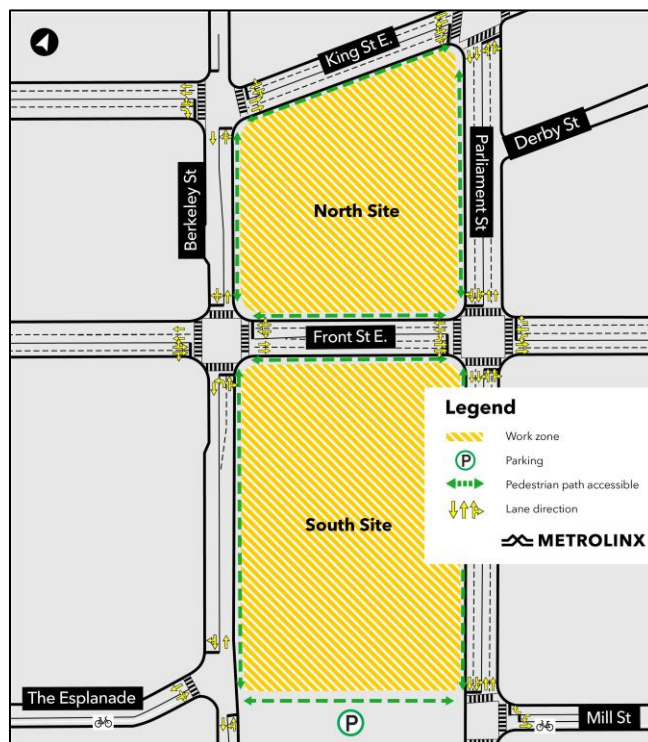
Update on Corktown Archaeological Investigations at the North Site

Expected start date: As early as December 6, 2023

Expected completion: Late January 2024

Hours of work: Monday to Saturday from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. (north site)

What is happening?

- Archaeological investigations, required by the Ministry of Citizenship and Culture (MCM), continue at the Corktown north and south sites.
- In order to expedite and complete investigations, working hours for archaeological investigations on the north site will be extended until 10 p.m.
- As shared in a previous notice, crews will be working under a winter tent. The tent is needed to keep the soil warm and dry so excavations can continue, while protecting the site from winter elements.

What to expect

- Archaeological crews will be working on the north site from Monday to Saturday between the hours of 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. There will be no Sunday work.
- Archaeological investigations at the south site will continue Monday to Saturday from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Extended hours of work may be required from time to time.
- It is likely that a second winter tent will be installed on the south site in December 2023.
- Noise levels are not expected to increase from current levels.
- Indigenous groups are aware of the ongoing work and will continue to provide archaeological monitoring as available.
- All roads and sidewalks in the area will remain open.
- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to unforeseen delays or weather conditions.
