
Overnight drilling near 1Queen Street East

Expected Start Date: As early as December 1, 2023

Expected End Date: December 9, 2023

Planned work hours: Overnight from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Fridays and Saturdays only



What is happening?

- Construction crews will be surveying and monitoring utilities and conducting sewer inspections within the construction site and in the areas shown in yellow on the map above.
- Crews will drill into the sidewalk to inspect utilities under the sidewalk. Once complete, the drill areas will be restored.
- Equipment such as a saw cutter and a hydrovac truck will be used.
- Work along 1 Queen Street East will occur Friday and Saturday's overnight from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

What to expect

- The south sidewalk on Queen Street East and a portion of the west sidewalk on Victoria will be closed for this work.
- Pedestrian access onto the north sidewalk on Queen Street East will be maintained through 2 Queen Street East, the same condition it is currently in. The 2 Queen Street East building will be extending its hours to ensure all pedestrians can have access easily through the building.
- Traffic control will be supervised by a Paid Duty Officer stationed at each side of the working zone, including the intersection of Queen Street East and Victoria Street, and the intersection of Queen Street East and Yonge Street, to ensure safety. There will also be flaggers directing pedestrian traffic at each side of the closure.
- Residents will hear noise from work equipment.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
- All the necessary construction permits have been obtained.
