Project Overview?

The Local Project

As a part of the GO Expansion Utility Early Works project, crews will be removing existing aerial attachments from utility poles within the Stouffville rail corridor. The work is part of the larger GO Expansion Program, which includes \$11 billion in early work projects currently underway to add more stations, tracks, and enhance the customer experience

What to expect

On December 20, 2023, Metrolinx contractors will remove an existing aerial attachment from poles within the Metrolinx right of way near Edward Street and Blake Street. **The contractor will be on site Wednesday from 9:00 a.m. to 11:15 a.m.** Nearby residents may experience increased noise levels as the work is being completed.

The south sidewalk on Main St. running parallel to the worksite will be closed for a short duration to complete the overhead work. Pedestrian barriers will be in place, as well as laborers to assist the pedestrian traffic. We apologize for the inconvenience and thank you for your patience as we complete the necessary work.
