UPDATE: Sewer and utility surveying on Berkeley Street, Front Street and King Street East

Street Locations: King Street East, Berkeley Street, Front Street, Nicholson Lane, Derby Street

Expected start date: As early as October 17, 2023 **Expected end date:** Up to January 31, 2024 **Hours of work:** Daytime (Monday to Friday) from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

What is happening?

- Pre-construction work is continuing at the Corktown site and surrounding area. Work crews will be performing sewer inspections, and utility services such as surveying, leak detection and cabling work, above and below the asphalt's surface.
- The work is done by accessing sewer manholes to assess the conditions of sewers and cabling.
- For investigative works, crews will drill asphalt to visualize the utilities below.
- Update: Work will be conducted intermittently on Front Street, King Street, Berkeley Street, Nicholson Lane and Derby Street and is expected to be completed by January 31, 2024.

What to expect

- Work will take place during the daytime between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. from Monday to Friday. <u>Lane Closures</u>
- There will be intermittent closures as follows:
 - Northbound and southbound lanes on Berkeley Street between Adelaide Street East and Nicholson Lane.
 - Eastbound lanes on Front Street, east of Berkeley Street
 - Eastbound and westbound lanes on King Street East at Berkeley Street
 - Eastbound lanes on Derby Street
 - o Westbound lanes on Nicholson Lane
- The westbound curb lane on Front Street, east of Berkeley Street, will be temporarily used as a pedestrian walkway to ensure pedestrian access is maintained while crews are working in that specific area.
- The northbound, centre, and left turn lane on Berkely Street to eastbound Front Street will temporarily transition to a southbound lane for Front Street traffic travelling southbound.

504 King Streetcar

- The existing TTC bus stop on Berkeley Street, south of Front Street will be temporarily moved 50m southbound for the duration of work.
- The King Street East streetcar schedule will be maintained with no interruptions to service.
- Flag-persons will be present to assist pedestrians and motorists where sidewalks and lane closures are in effect.
- Police will be present to assist motorists at King Street East and Berkeley Street.
- Safety barriers will be used to separate motorists and pedestrians from construction zones and active traffic lanes.
- Pedestrian passageways will be maintained with some detours in effect on Front Street east of Berkeley Street and King Street East, east and west of Berkeley Street.
- Two-way traffic to be maintained on all streets at all times.
- Clear signage will be posted for pedestrians and motorists.
- Separate crews will complete different segments of work, moving within the various locations noted on the map.



- Each type of work will be scheduled for one to two days, moving between identified locations throughout the duration of work.
- As a result, all closures for work are temporary and intermittent; areas will only be closed while crews are surveying the specific area.
- Residents and businesses near the work zones will hear noise from heavy equipment including a hydrovac truck, drill rig, and saw cutter. Crews will take measures to minimize noise impacts wherever possible.
- Equipment will be cleared after every shift.
- All the necessary construction permits have been obtained.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
