Overview

The first Pape Jr School Construction Liaison Committee meeting was held virtually on Tuesday February 28, 2023. There were 18 members from the Parent Council in attendance, 3 from Pape Jr School and 2 representatives of Elected Officials. Metrolinx team provided background information on the work that is expected to take place in the Pape Jr School area, expected impacts and mitigation measures. The sewer which runs beneath Pape Avenue needs to be relocated to the area beneath the Pape Jr School playground to facilitate the Ontario Line Tunnel Boring Machine. Prior to this happening, utilities companies Bell, Enbridge and Toronto Hydro will need to relocate their conduits. This information was initially shared with the Parent Council in November 2022. With the knowledge of this, the community had shared several concerns primarily safety and construction related.

The Metrolinx team provided the group with a high level, detailed presentation which was broken down into three sections. These included:

- Health and Safety
- Upcoming Construction
 - o Utilities Relocation
 - o Sewer Relocation
- Environmental Testing

Each of these categories were covered by Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) and at the end of the presentation, each expert shouldered the questions that arose from the section they presented on.

Next Steps

- Site specific safety plan for Pape Jr School to be created
- Information to be "re-packaged" and presented to the group (What does all this mean for children?)
- Children specific answers to be presented to the group (noise levels and airquality studies specifically for kids)
- Future CLC meetings to take on a more conversational format
