# Evans Avenue Road Closure-December 8th to 11th




Figure 1: A map depicted the approximate work zone. Not to scale. For illustrative purposes only.

# What Is Happening

There will be a upcoming Road closure at Evans Avenue Road due to crossing maintenance work. Work consists of removal of concrete crossing panels, asphalt, replacement of any damaged or worn track components and track surface, installation of rubber rail seal and pavement. Residents can expect road closures, detours, and elevated levels of noise. All efforts will be made to minimize community impacts.

# **Project Overview**

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter

#### WHAT TO EXPECT

- Work is scheduled from December 8<sup>th</sup> at 9 pm to December 11<sup>th</sup> at 5am
- The local community will experience road closures on Evans Avenue
- Residents and businesses near the worksite can expect to hear elevated levels of noise.
- All efforts will be made to minimize community impacts.

#### **HOURS OF WORK**

- Overnight work will be taking place.
- The work will take approximately 3 days and be completed between the hours of 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
- Dates may be rescheduled to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.

## **LOCATION OF WORK**

 The work will take place between Evans Avenue and Wickman Road

#### PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Pedestrians sidewalks will be accommodated during this closure
- Please watch for slow-moving construction vehicles and equipment which may be entering/exiting the work zone.

#### TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Detour routes will be available from browns Line, Kipling Ave, Lanor Avenue, and Bellman Avenue
