

Traffic Configuration Change at Eglinton Avenue and Yonge Street for Road Restoration Works

As early as Friday, December 8, 2023





What Work is Taking Place?

As early as Friday, December 8, 2023, at 7:00 p.m. and continuing through until Monday, December 11, 2023, at approximately 7:00 a.m., crews at Eglinton Station will be continuing road restoration works on Eglinton Avenue and Yonge Street. To facilitate this work safely, eastbound and westbound traffic on Eglinton Avenue will be reduced to one alternating lane at Yonge Street. Traffic on Yonge Street will flip to the east side of the road and a work zone will be in place on the west side. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times on Yonge Street. Flaggers and a Paid Duty Officer will be present to help facilitate traffic movements. This work will take place on a 24-hour basis.

Following the completion of this work, on Monday, December 11, 2023, at approximately 7:00 a.m., traffic on Yonge Street will remain on the east side of the road and the work zone will remain on the west side. Traffic on Eglinton Avenue will return to one lane per direction, at 2200 Yonge Street will shift to the south side of the road and the work zones will be in place on the north side. Traffic on Eglinton Avenue, east of Yonge Street, will remain on the south side of the road and the work zone will remain on the north side. All turn restrictions will remain in place at the intersection.

What to Expect

Noise from construction activities can be expected. Concrete barriers, fencing, and signage will be in place to delineate the work zones. Traffic control personnel and Paid Duty Officer will be present when this work takes place. Expect delays while traveling through the area.

HOURS OF WORK

- As early as Friday, December 8, 2023, at 7:00 p.m. and ongoing until approximately Monday, December 11, 2023, at 7:00 a.m.
- Work is expected to take place on a 24-hour basis.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- Work may be longer or shorter than expected.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Eastbound and westbound traffic on Eglinton Avenue will be reduced to one alternating lane at Yonge Street.
- Traffic on Yonge Street will shift to the east side of the road and a work zone will be in place on the west side.
- One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times on Yonge Street.
- Flaggers and a Paid Duty Officer will be present to help facilitate traffic movements.
- Following the completion of this work, traffic on Yonge Street will remain on the east side of the road and the work zone will remain on the west side. Traffic on Eglinton Avenue will return to one lane per direction, 2200 Yonge Street will shift to the south side of the road and the work zones will be in place on the north side. Traffic on Eglinton Avenue, east of Yonge Street, will remain on the south side of the road and the work zone will remain on the north side.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

• No changes to the current pedestrian routes are expected as a result of this work.
