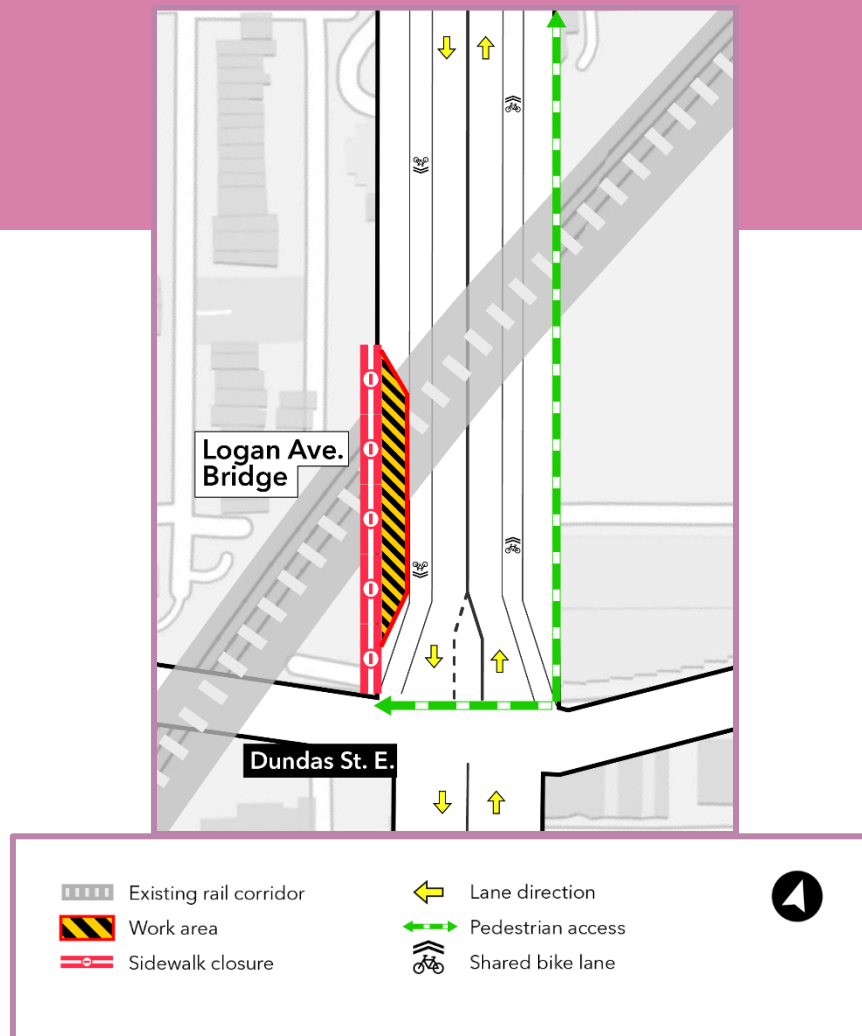


Saw Cutting at the Logan Avenue Bridge

Expected start date: Wednesday, December 13, 2023

Expected duration: One week

Hours of work: Weekdays Monday - Friday, 7 a.m. - 5 p.m.



What is happening?

- Starting as early as Wednesday, December 13, 2023, crews will begin to cut and remove concrete at the Logan Avenue bridge
- Construction activities will include saw cutting and concrete removals
- This work will take place between 7 a.m. - 5 p.m. for approximately one week

- Temporary sidewalk closures and parking restrictions will be required to complete this work safely. Please review the traffic and pedestrian details section below for specific details.

Traffic and pedestrian details

- The sidewalk on the west side of Logan Avenue will be closed while this work takes place. **The sidewalk will reopen after each work day.**
- Pedestrians will be directed to use the existing crosswalks at Dundas Street East and First Avenue.
- No traffic lane closures are expected.
- Street parking on the west side of Logan Avenue will be restricted at and around the bridge. Replacement parking is available at 10 Dickens Street. Please refer to the "Parking Details" section below for further information.

What to expect

- Concrete will be cut into pieces using a saw. The cut up pieces of concrete will then be loading into dump trucks using excavators and loaders and hauled off site in dump trucks for disposal.
- Noise from construction equipment including excavators, loaders saws, and dump trucks.
- Temporary pedestrian detours will be in place.
- Parking restrictions on the west side of Logan Avenue adjacent to the rail bridge.
- Advance signage will be in place to direct pedestrians.
- Traffic barrels, fencing, and barriers will be in place to separate and secure work zones.
- Construction equipment and materials will be properly secured within the work zones.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

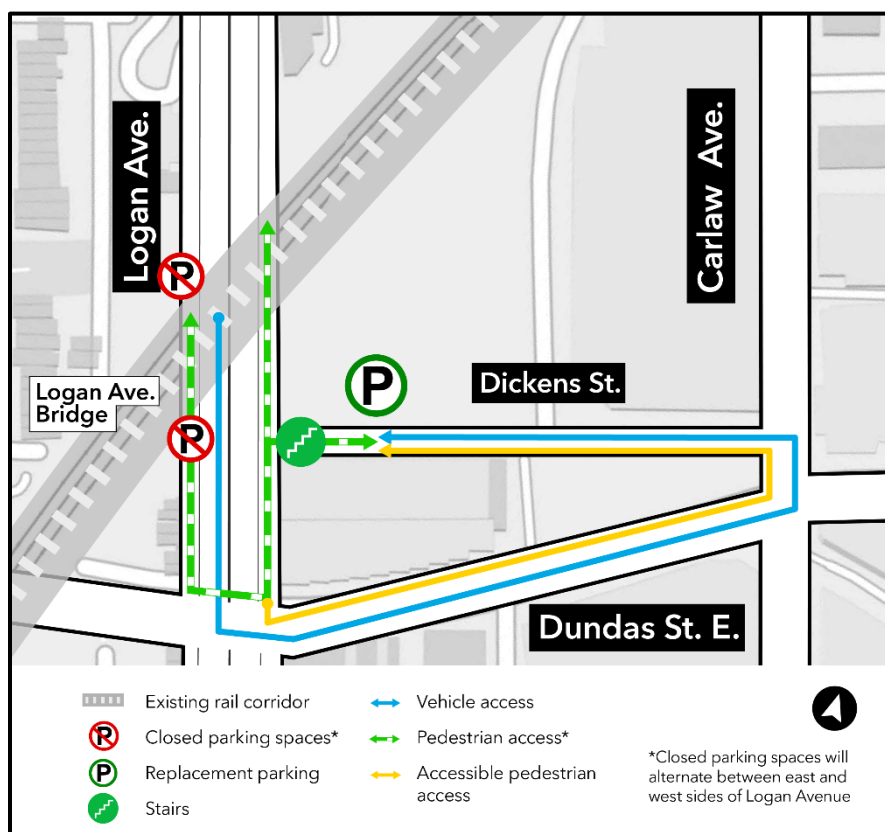

Parking details



- Approximately eight (8) on-street parking spaces will be restricted on the west side of the Logan Avenue bridge between Dundas Street East and 444 Logan Avenue.
- Free replacement parking is available for the community at 10 Dickens Street.
- The parking lot at 10 Dickens Street can be accessed by vehicle via Dundas Street East and Carlaw Avenue which also provides accessible pedestrian connection to the parking lot. Pedestrian access to the parking lot is also available via a staircase on the east side of Logan Avenue approximately 50 metres north of Dundas Street East.
- Please refer to the map above for further details on replacement parking routes and parking displacements.

About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Approximately 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
