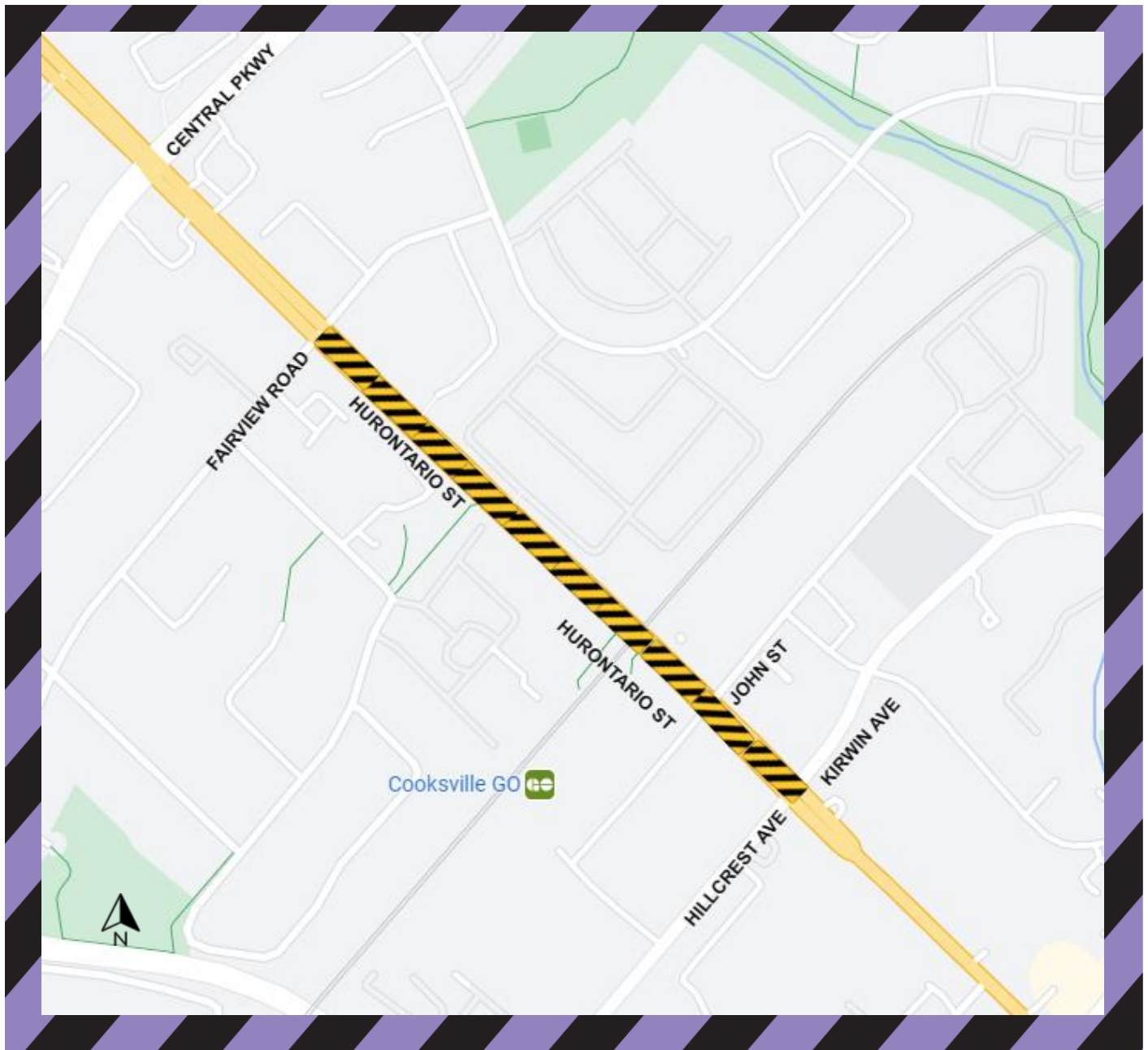


Temporary Driveway Impacts on Hurontario from Fairview Road to Hillcrest Avenue

Beginning December 14th to December 21st, 2023



What work is taking place?

As Hazel McCallion LRT project works continue, crews will be paving the roadway between Fairview Road and Hillcrest Avenue. These works are scheduled to take place from December 14-21, 2023. To safely accommodate these works, driveways for properties within this stretch will be intermittently impacted between 7 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. These works will not occur on weekends.

Please note that this does not require any open cut excavation on impacted driveways.

TIMING

- Work is scheduled between December 14-21, 2023.
- Work involving driveway closures will generally occur between 7 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday to Friday. There will be no weekend work for these activities.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Lane reductions will be required on Hurontario Street.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- MiWay will continue to operate with regular service.
- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.
- Visit www.miway.ca/updates for updates on your bus route.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Sidewalk access could be impacted
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians & cyclists as detours will be required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

PROPERTY DETAILS

- Crews will not require access to private property. All works will take place within the public right of way.
- For details on your property boundaries, please refer to your land survey, or consult an Ontario Land Surveyor.
- Driveways are expected to be intermittently impacted between the hours of 7 a.m. and 4 p.m., as crews work from pole to pole between Mineola Road East and Pinewood Trail.
