
Long Branch GO: Partial Platform Closures

Starting December 04, 2023

What You Need to Know

Starting December 04, 2023, crews will be closing the east side of the platforms to start work on the east tunnel, platform rehabilitation, and east station building. Stairway access from Edgeware Drive will be closed. Customers will be redirected to a temporary access route which connects to the north platform and tunnel at the west end of the station. The partial closure of the platforms will change how you board the GO train, as not all train doors will open at Long Branch GO. Project Overview

Metrolinx's GO Expansion program is delivering more GO service across the network, including trains every 15- minutes or better on the Lakeshore West Rail Corridor. To support GO Expansion, we are upgrading the rail network and our GO stations to enable more frequent and fully accessible service. This includes accessibility and amenity improvements to Toronto's Long Branch GO Station.

What to Expect

- Residents should expect some noise, vibration, dust, and site lighting.
- Our operations staff will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and commuters.

Hours of Work

- Day work is expected to take place Monday to Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- Overnight work is expected to take place Monday to Saturday between 7:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. Certain activities within the rail corridor are required to take place overnight when train service is not operational.

Mitigation Measures

- Lights will be pointed away from residential windows.
- Work area will be safely delineated.
- Construction noise and vibration will be monitored.
- Street sweeper and cleaning as required.

Customer Details

- Construction affects how you board and exit your GO train.
- Please follow the signs and pathway to the train

platforms.

- When travelling to Long Branch GO, ensure you are sitting in a coach that will open its doors.
- When boarding from Union Station, listen for announcements from the Customer Service Ambassador located in the Accessibility Coach.

Traffic Details

- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.
- Please exercise caution around active construction sites.

Pedestrian Details

- North staircase access on Edgeware Drive will be closed as of December 04, 2023.
- Pedestrian access to the station from the north will be via a temporary access route which will connect you to the north platform and tunnel at the west end of the station.
