PROJECT INFORMATION

Metrolinx's GO Expansion program is delivering more GO service across the network, including trains every 15- minutes or better on the Lakeshore West Rail Corridor. To support GO Expansion, we are upgrading the rail network and our GO stations to enable more frequent and fully accessible service. This includes accessibility and amenity improvements to Toronto's Long Branch GO Station located at 20 Brow Drive in Etobicoke.

WHAT WORK IS TAKING PLACE?

Construction crews will be mobilizing on Friday November 24, 2023. This includes the set-up of construction areas, site office and laydown area along Edgeware Drive. installation of erosion and sediment control measures, as well as fencing.

Laydown Area Preparation and Mobilization – Edgeware Drive	November 24, 2023	Ongoing	Day Shift	Preparation of the construction laydown area will involve the installation of temporary fences, gates, an access ramp, and signage to show the work and access areas. Office trailers will be stationed within the designated laydown area on the north side of Edgeware Drive.
Removal of Shrubs and Trees	December 2023	Approx. 1 week	Day Shift	Small amounts of shrubs and trees within the rail corridor will be removed to allow for construction activities.
Temporary Power Connection	December 2023	Approx. 2 weeks	Day Shift	Temporary power connections will be made at the construction laydown area. This is to provide power to the site office trailers.

Day work is expected to take place Monday to Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

 Overnight work may be required for safety when there is less train activity and is expected to take place Monday to Saturday between 7:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.

HOURS OF WORK

Residents should expect some noise, vibration, dust, and site lighting. Our operation staff will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and commuters, including but not limited to the following:

- No idling of non-essential equipment
- Pointing lights away from residential windows
- The work area will be safely delineated.

- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.
- Pedestrians will not be impacted at this time.
- Please exercise caution around active construction sites.
