Update: Lower Jarvis Street Sidewalk Impacts and Evening Work

End Date: February 2024



What is happening?

A crane pad is being installed just south of the tracks and will support the upcoming bridge extension construction work. This work is currently ongoing and will continue into February 2024. There is an increased level of construction activity at street level, south of the Lower Jarvis Street rail corridor bridge. This work involves an excavator, a loader and vacuum truck deployment.

To facilitate this needed work, the west and east sidewalks along Lower Jarvis Street from Lakeshore Boulevard to just north of the rail bridge will experience alternating closures, with one sidewalk fully open at all times. The east sidewalk is temporarily closed until 2024, followed by the west sidewalk until February 2024. Directional signage will be used to assistance pedestrians through this area.

Please note, that access to the Crombie Park and Cathedral Court communities will remain open during this construction period. We appreciate your ongoing patience and understanding of this necessary work. Date subject to change.
