
Overnight Corridor Work

Work will occur at different locations and on different dates along the corridor

Wednesday January 3, 2024 - Thursday February 29, 2024



Project Overview

The Davenport Diamond Guideway project supports Metrolinx's GO Expansion program, enabling two-way, all-day frequent service on the Barrie GO Line. GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What You Need to Know

Upcoming works occurring at different locations and on different dates within the Metrolinx corridor from 600m from south of Bloor St to 300m north of Davenport Rd and on the elevated guideway include track surface finishing; structures surface finishing and fiberglass reinforced plastic grating (adjustments, electrical and communications equipment adjustments for CCTV and lighting, and architectural component finishings, including cladding and flashing installation. Information on dates and locations of each of these aspects of work are tentative and may be subject to change due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. Work will be conducted as quickly and efficiently as possible to minimize disturbance but residents and businesses in the area can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, equipment, machinery, and crews.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Noise - Back-up Alarms, all vehicles to be equipped with broadband backup alarms. Operational Equipment Noise, no vehicle or equipment idling, Equipment noise and increased truck traffic.

- Noise impacts All vehicles and equipment on site will be equipped with backup alarms.
- Artificial Lighting impacts All light plants will be pointed in the direction of the corridor and facing the ground as not to shine in any business or residential windows.
- Equipment used:
 - a) Pickup Truck
 - b) F550 HiRail
 - c) Wheel Loader
 - d) Boom truck
 - e) Tamper
 - f) Ballast Regulator
 - g) Wheel excavator with concrete Tie Jig
 - h) Crane
