

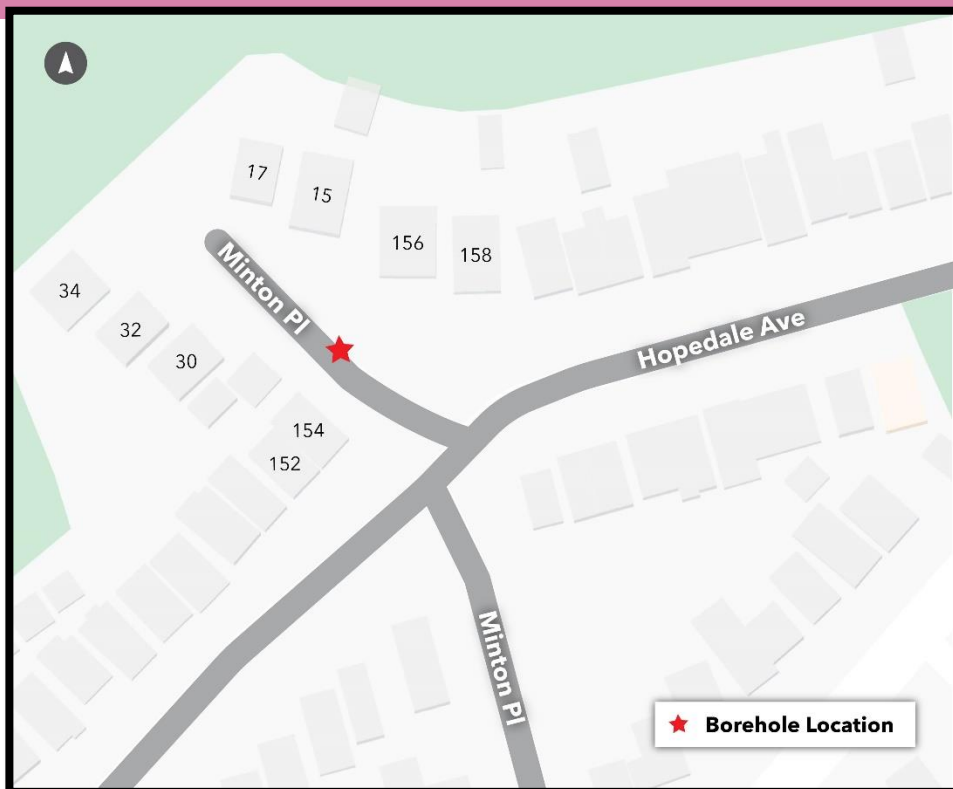
Drilling to install monitoring point on Minton Place

Expected start date: As early as January 8, 2024

Expected completion date: January 19, 2024

Hours of work: Weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Days of work: Monday to Friday



What is happening?

- As early as Monday, January 8, Metrolinx will install a single monitoring point on the street in front of 15 Minton Place to gather information about the existing underground conditions in support of design and construction plans for the northern part of the future Ontario Line subway.
- This work involves drilling a borehole, installing monitoring equipment, and using this equipment to sample groundwater.
- A drill rig, a hydrovac truck, and a service truck will be used during drilling and monitoring equipment installation. A truck will be used to remove drums containing drill cuttings.

- Groundwater monitoring and sampling will be done using hand-held instruments after the drilling and monitoring equipment installation.

What to expect

- Temporary lane closure on Minton Place.
- Safety control measures such as signage will be in place to direct vehicles and pedestrians
- The work area will be delineated with traffic cones and/or construction pylons.
- Borehole drilling and monitoring equipment installation is expected to take 3-4 hours to complete but could take up to one day.
- A drill rig, a hydrovac truck, and a service truck will be used to complete the work.
- Residents may experience noise, such as vehicle idling and occasional hammering sounds, from the construction equipment.
- Any equipment left on-site will be secured with fencing and safety signage.
- Security personnel may be present on-site in some areas.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to unforeseen weather conditions.

About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
