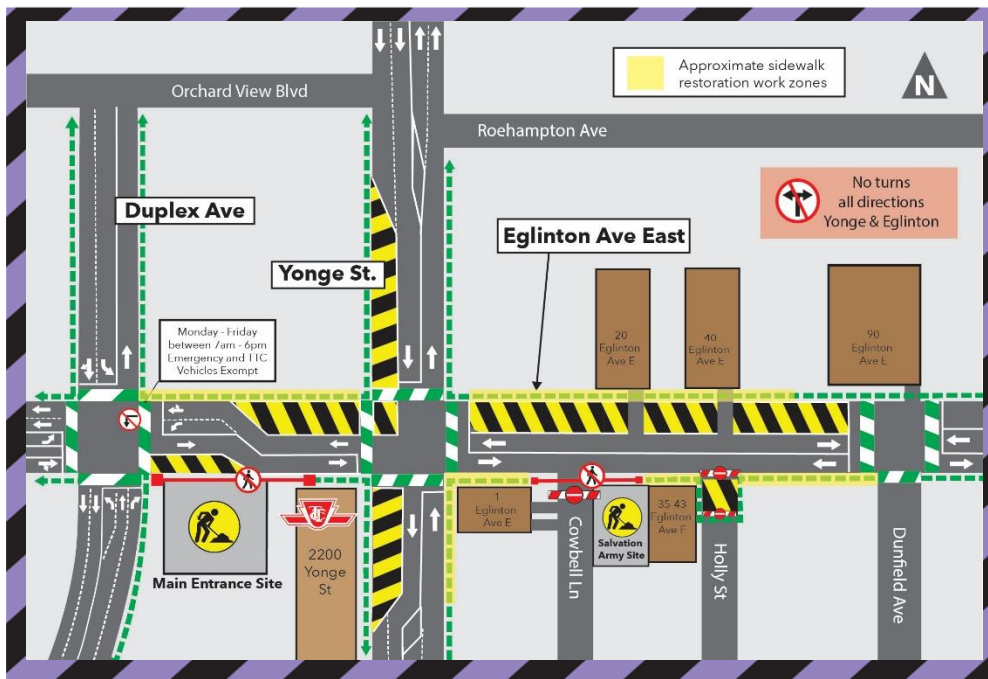


Updated: Sidewalk Restoration Works at Eglinton Avenue and Yonge Street

Early-January 2024



What Work is Taking Place?

In early-January 2024, crews at Eglinton Station will be performing sidewalk restoration works at multiple locations on Eglinton Avenue and Yonge Street. To facilitate this work safely, periodic lane reductions and sidewalk closures will be in place on Eglinton Avenue and Yonge Street. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times. Temporary pedestrian rerouting will be in effect in areas where crews are performing restoration works. Ramps will be installed in the immediate area where work is taking place to maintain access to properties at all times. This work is expected to take on Monday - Friday **on a 24-hour basis** until approximately late-January 2024. Upon completion of this work, short term lane reductions may be required to facilitate special activities.

What to Expect

Traffic barrels and fencing will be in place to delineate pedestrians from the work zones and traffic. Temporary pedestrian rerouting will be implemented. **Overnight** noise from construction activity including concrete breaking and truck staging can be expected. Periodic use of a hydro-vacuum truck will be required to facilitate certain works. Access to properties will be maintained at all times. Expect delays while travelling through the intersection.

HOURS OF WORK

- In early-January 2024, and ongoing until approximately late-January 2024.
- Work is expected to take on Monday - Friday **on a 24-hour basis**.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- Work may be longer or shorter than expected.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Periodic lane reductions will be in place on Eglinton Avenue and Yonge Street.
- One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times on Eglinton Avenue and Yonge Street.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Periodic sidewalk closures will be in place on Eglinton Avenue and Yonge Street.
- Temporary pedestrian rerouting will be in effect in areas where crews are performing restoration works.
- Ramps will be installed in the immediate area where work is taking place to maintain access to properties at all times.
- Advanced signage will be in place to help direct pedestrians.
