

UPDATE: Partial Intersection Closure for Track Installation at Topflight Drive and Hurontario Street

Friday June 16, 2023 at 10 p.m., to Thursday February 1, 2024 at 10 p.m.



What work is taking place?

Important work to install tracks along Hurontario Street continues, requiring turning restrictions at the intersection of Topflight Drive and Hurontario Street. Crews will be excavating the roadway at the intersection to install tracks and pour concrete to construct the LRT guideway. This will enable the light rail vehicles to move between Hurontario Street and the Operations Maintenance and Storage Facility (OMSF). During this process, motorists will not be able to access Topflight Drive via Hurontario Street. All traffic on Topflight Drive will not be permitted onto Hurontario Street. Detours routes are available via Derry Road and Edwards Boulevard. The closure at Topflight Drive and Hurontario Street will take place from **Friday June 16, 2023 at 10 p.m.**, until **Thursday February 1, 2024 at 10 p.m.**

Construction work at this intersection is scheduled to take place from 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, until completion. Access for emergency vehicles across Hurontario Street at Topflight Drive will not be maintained. Traffic signal timings will be adjusted to keep people moving. Pedestrian crossings will be maintained at a signalized crosswalk. Please follow the signs installed to assist with navigating around the closure.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axes, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. If you require the most up-to-date information, please reach out to peel@metrolinx.com and our team will provide you with e-updates of this work.

TIMING

- Work at Topflight Drive and Hurontario Street is scheduled from June 16, 2023, until February 1, 2024.
- Construction is scheduled to occur from 24/7.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Access to Topflight Drive from Hurontario Street will not be permitted.
- Access to Hurontario Street from Topflight Drive will not be permitted.
- Access for emergency vehicles will not be maintained.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

TRANSIT IMPACT DETAILS

- MiWay Route 17 will be detoured via Derry and Edwards.

- Visit MiWay.ca, BramptonTransit.com and gotransit.com for updates on your bus route.
- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Access to properties will be maintained.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when walking or cycling near construction areas and watch for additional signs directing the public such as detours and dismounting.
