

Lane Closures on Burloak Drive

January 29, 2024



Project Overview

Metrolinx's GO Expansion program is delivering more GO Service across the network, including trains every 15- minutes or better on the Lakeshore West Rail Corridor. We are upgrading the rail network and our GO stations to enable more frequent and fully accessible service. Metrolinx is working with the City of Burlington and the Town of Oakville to build a grade separation (building a road under the rail corridor) at Burloak Drive. This work will enhance pedestrian and vehicular safety and will optimize traffic flow at this crossing.

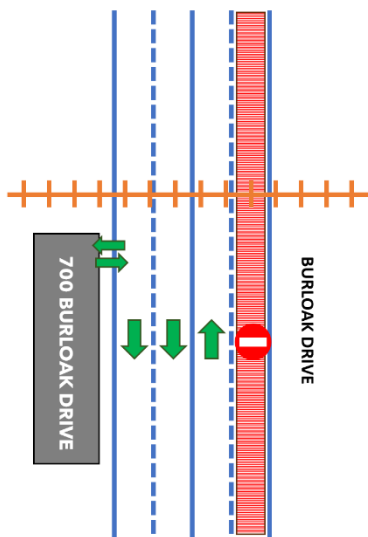
WHAT TO EXPECT

Starting **January 29** until **February 16** we are installing a duct bank on Burloak Drive between Harvester / Wyecroft Road and Superior Court / Prince William Drive.

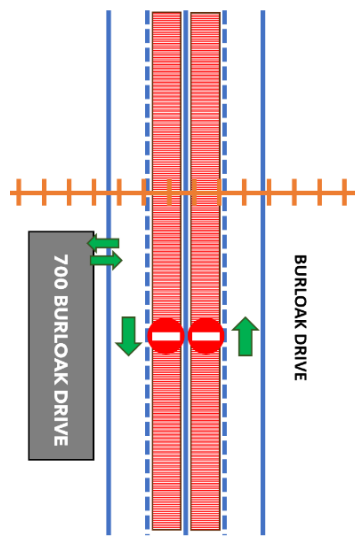
During this work, there will be short-term lane closures that will start from 9am and end at 3pm, Monday to Friday (see phasing plan below). Please note that short term lane closures will occur until the end of April 2024.

Reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and businesses include, but are not limited to the following:

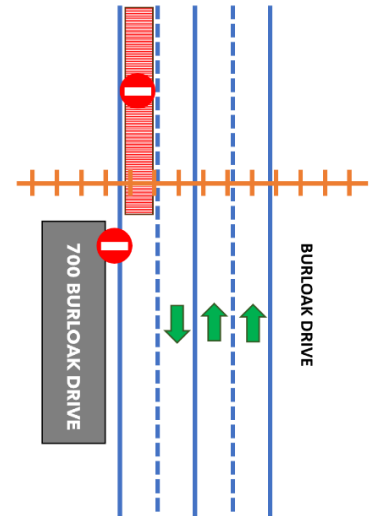
- Ongoing monitoring for noise and dust
- Regular sweeping of streets.
- Two-way traffic will be always maintained.
- Pedestrian and cyclist traffic will be maintained.



Phase 1 (29 January to 2 February): Closure of the northbound east curb lane. All the other lanes will remain open.



Phase 2 (5 February to 9 February): Closure of both the north and southbound middle lanes. North and southbound curb lanes will remain open.



Phase 3 (12-16 February): Closure of the southbound west curb Lane on Burloak Drive. During the week of February 12, the Burloak Drive entrance to the plaza at 700 Burloak Drive will be closed daily between 9am and 3pm. The exit will remain for delivery vehicles and emergency services.
